



ESC REMOVAL/REPLACEMENT

- 1. Ensure that the battery is disconnected, then remove cowl and motor.
- 2. Cut zip tie holding motor wires to the motor mount.
- 3. Attach a 12" string to the three motor wires where they protrude through the metal motor mount (pictured).



- 4. Remove the battery hatch under the front of fuselage.
- 5. Carefully cut a 1" [25.4mm] x 1.5" [38mm] hole in the foam directly under the esc (pictured).
- 6. Slowly remove ESC partially.
- 7. Once string is visible from under side of fuse, remove string from old esc.



- 8. Attach string to new ESC bullet connector wires (pictured).
- 9. Pull the string through the firewall.
- 10. Remove string from new ESC, and attach the bullet connectors to the motor.
- 11. Use new zip tie to secure ESC/motor wires to motor mount.
- 12. Reassemble motor and cowl to the Super Cub.
