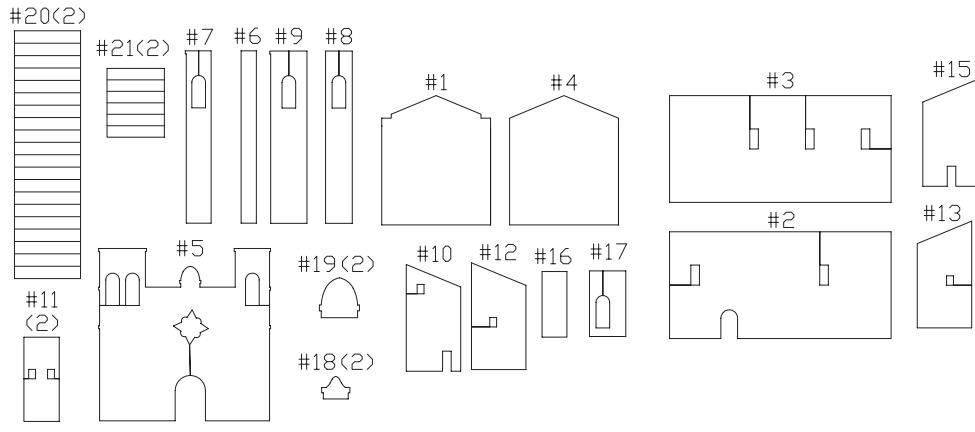


# San Carlos Borromeo de Carmelo Instructions

## Parts Drawing

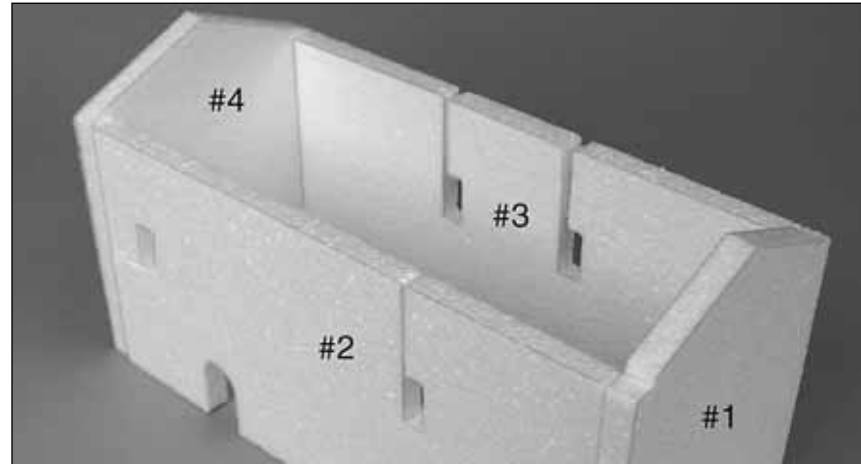
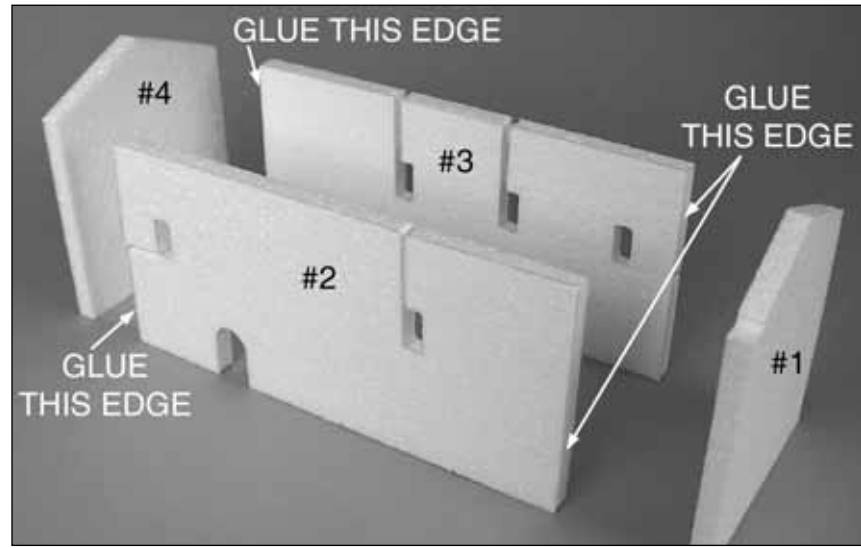


- Before starting assembly, read through each step of the instructions and carefully study each photo. As you put the model together, it is a good idea to "test" fit the pieces together before using any glue.
- Spread out newspaper across the table or desk that you are working on. This will help to protect your work surface.
- Use scissors to trim any pieces where needed. PARENTAL SUPERVISION is recommended.
- Identify each piece of the model by matching it with the parts drawing above.
- Assemble the model with standard white glue. It is a good idea to hold the pieces together with toothpicks until the glue is dry. Once the glue is dry, twist the toothpick and carefully pull it out.
- Use a small brush, flat stick, or your finger to spread glue evenly on the surface.
- Do not glue any of the pieces to the base until after step 6.

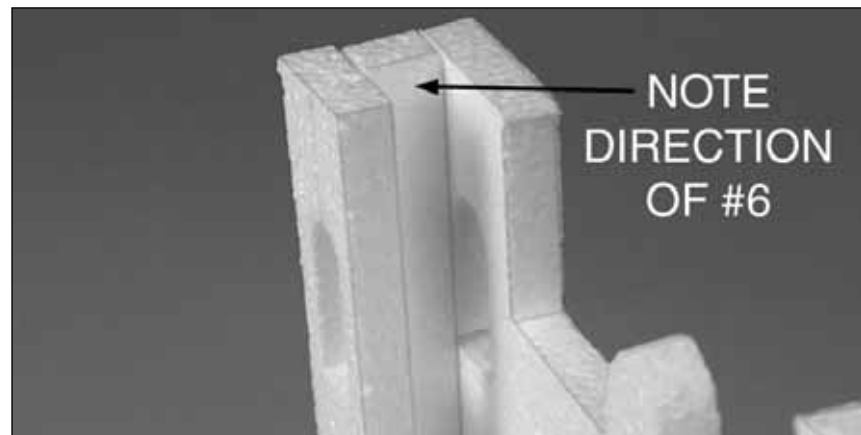
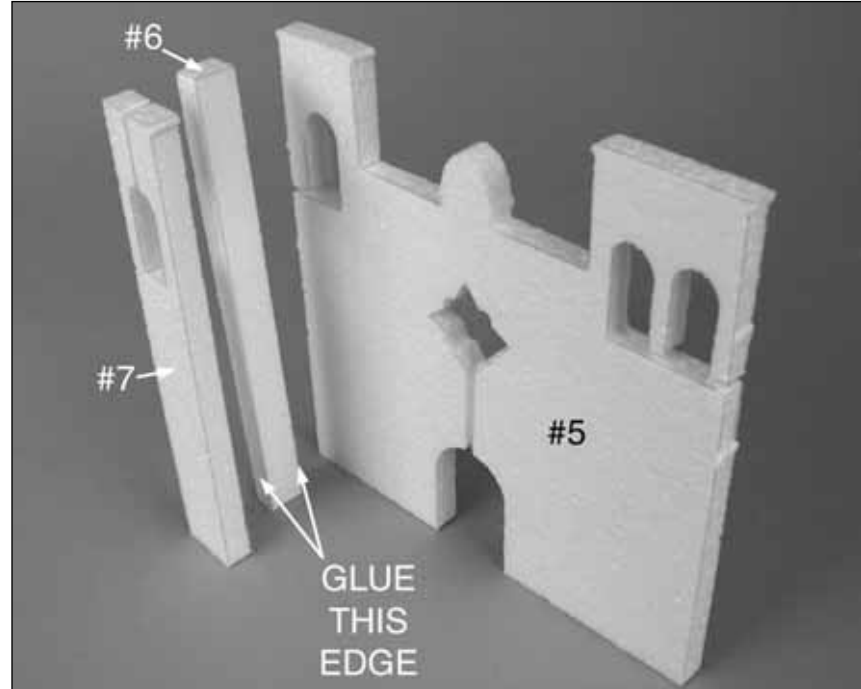
Note: The missions can either be assembled on the cardboard sheet (included) or on a sheet of foam (not included).

## ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

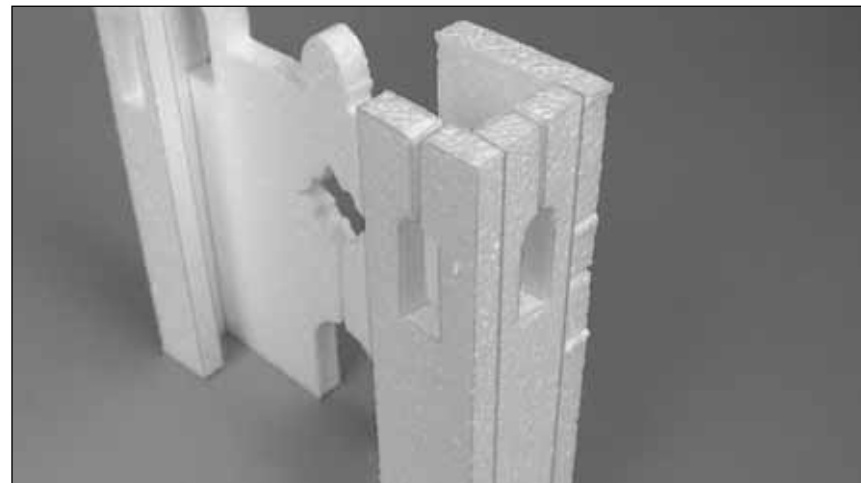
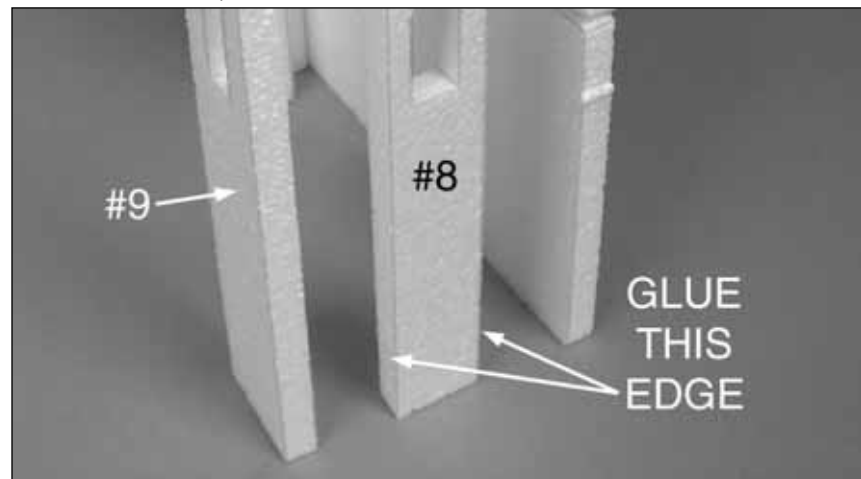
1. Place the 24" x 15" base on a clean, flat surface.
2. Apply glue along the front edges of #2, and #3 and place it against #1 as shown below. Apply glue on the rear edges of #2 and #3 and put #4 in place. This section will be called the "main building."



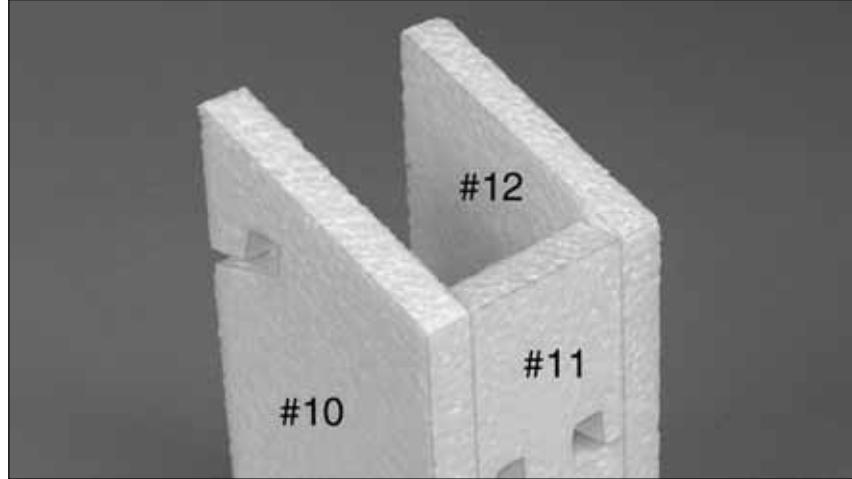
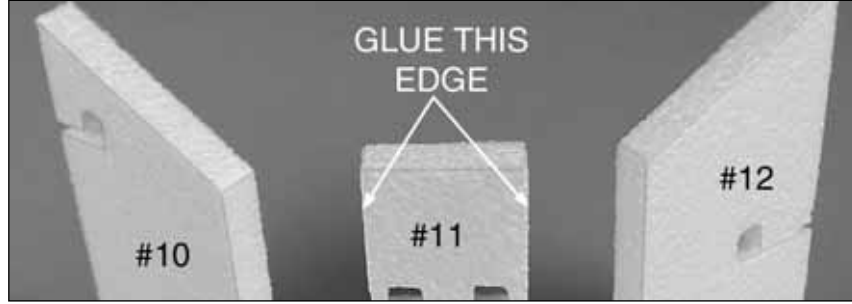
3. Locate pieces #6 and #7. Glue them to #5 as shown below, making sure that all edges are even. Note the direction of #6 as shown below.



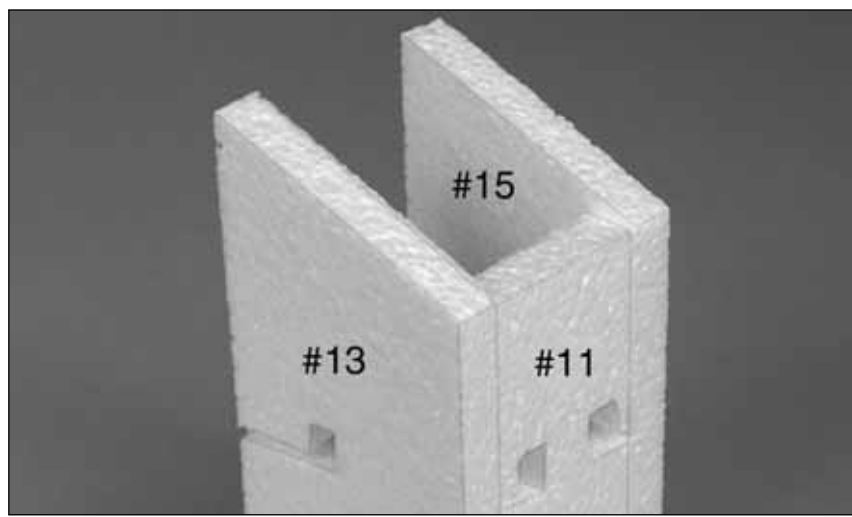
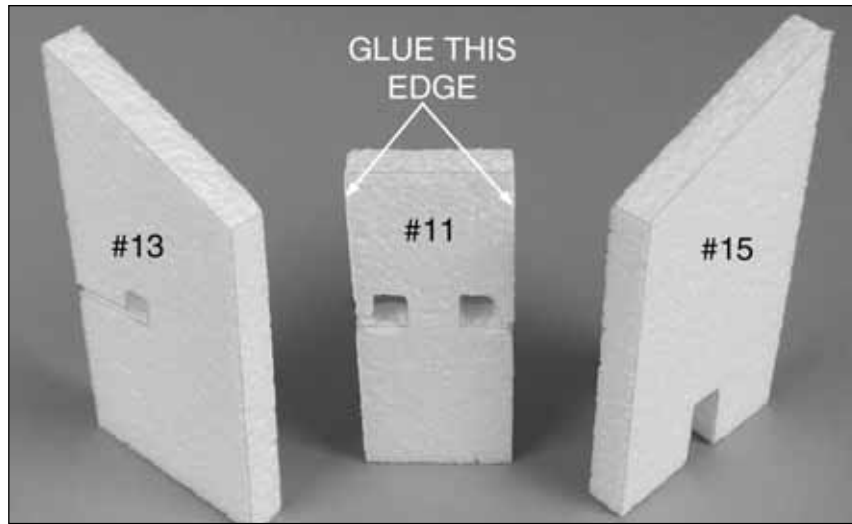
4. Locate pieces #8 and #9. Glue them to #5 as shown below making sure that all edges are even. This section will be called the "bell tower assembly."



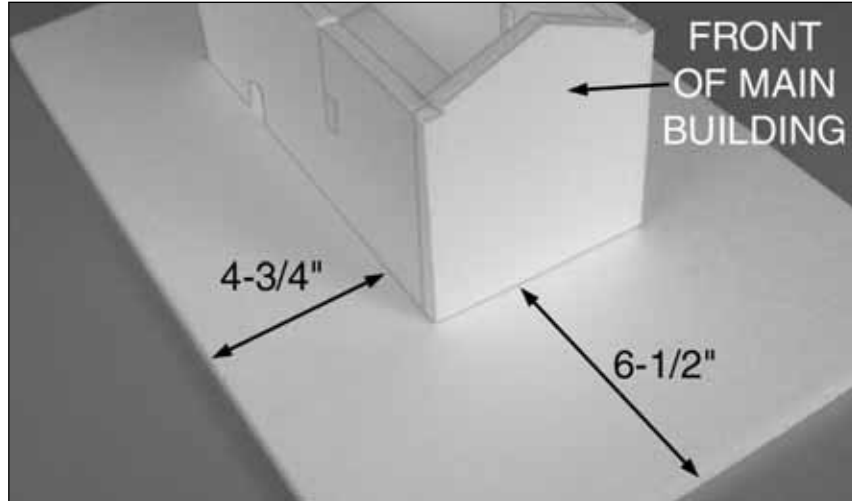
5. Locate pieces #10, #11, and #12. Glue them together as shown below. This section will be called the "back room."



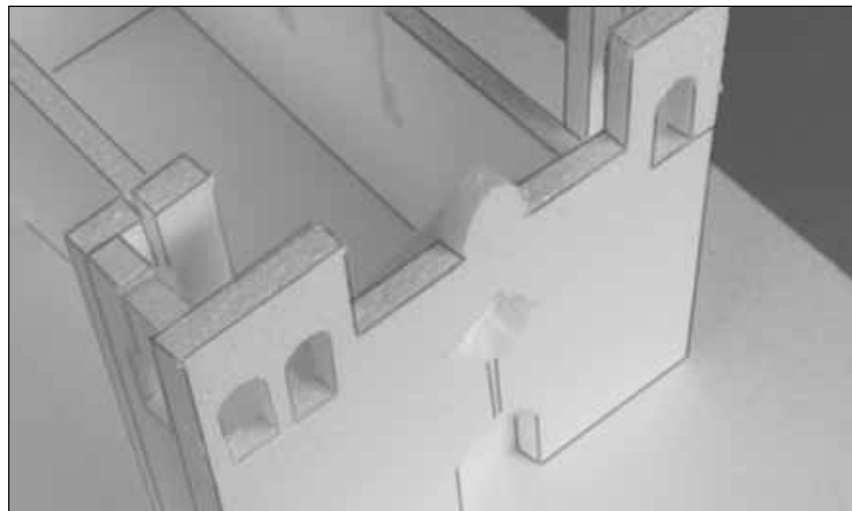
6. Locate pieces #13, #11, and #15. Glue them together as shown below. This section will be called the "side room."



7. Glue the main building to the base. There should be 6-1/2" from the front of the base to the front door. The left side of the main building should be about 4-3/4" from the edge of the base. This will leave you enough room to create scenery for your model.



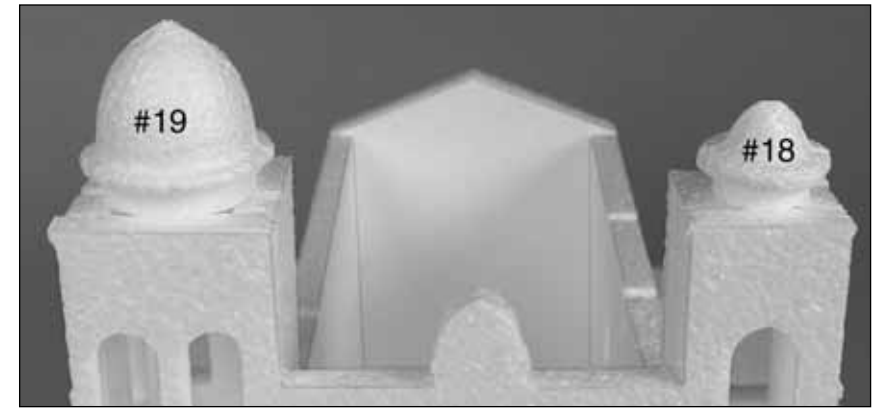
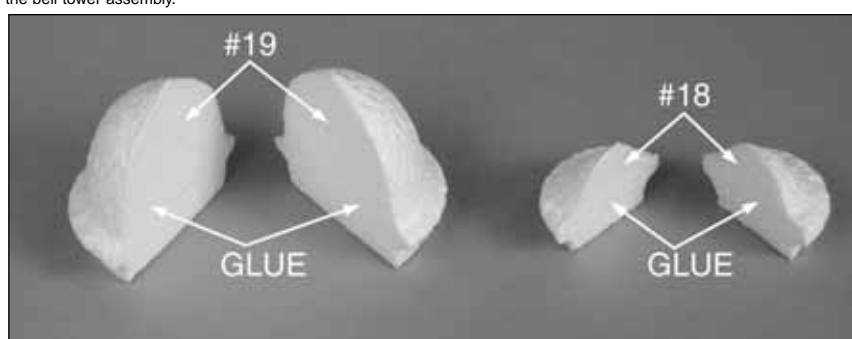
8. Glue the bell tower in place as shown below.



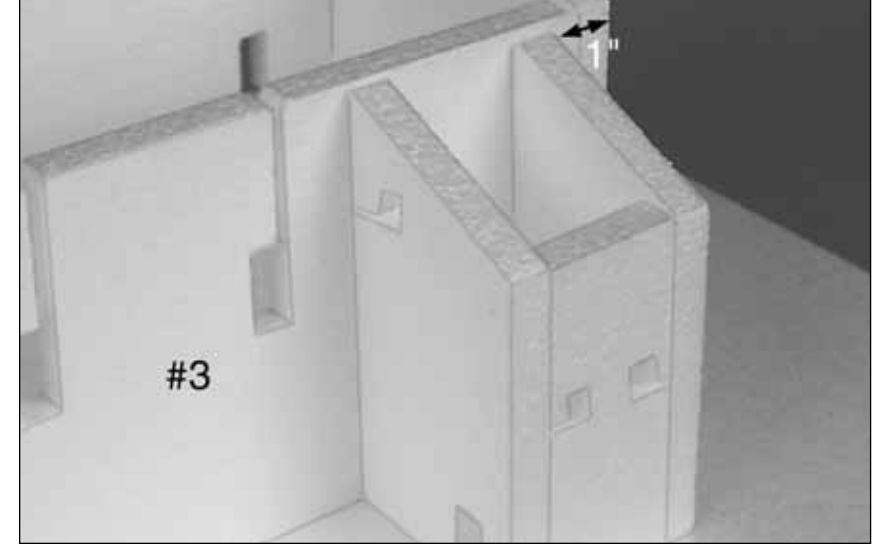
9. Glue pieces #16 and #17 into place as shown below in the photo below, making sure the edges are even.



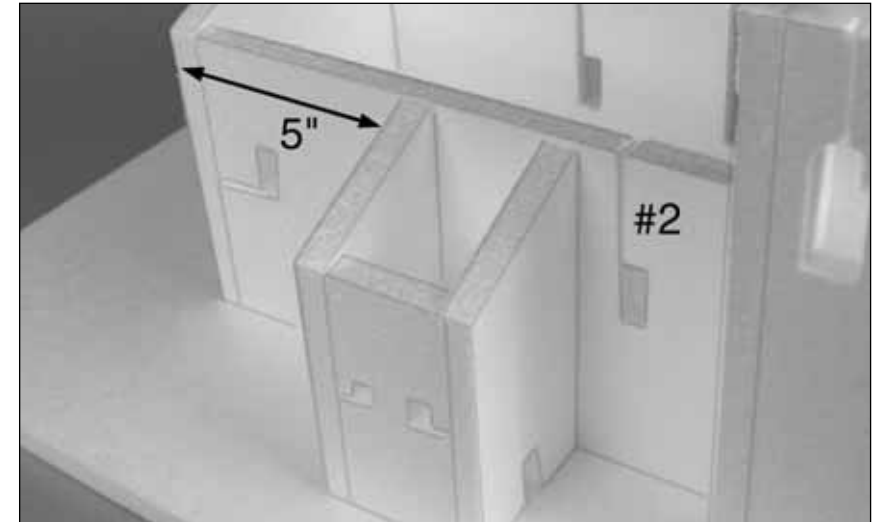
10. Glue both #18 pieces and both #19 pieces together as shown in the two photos that follow. Glue them in place atop the bell tower assembly.



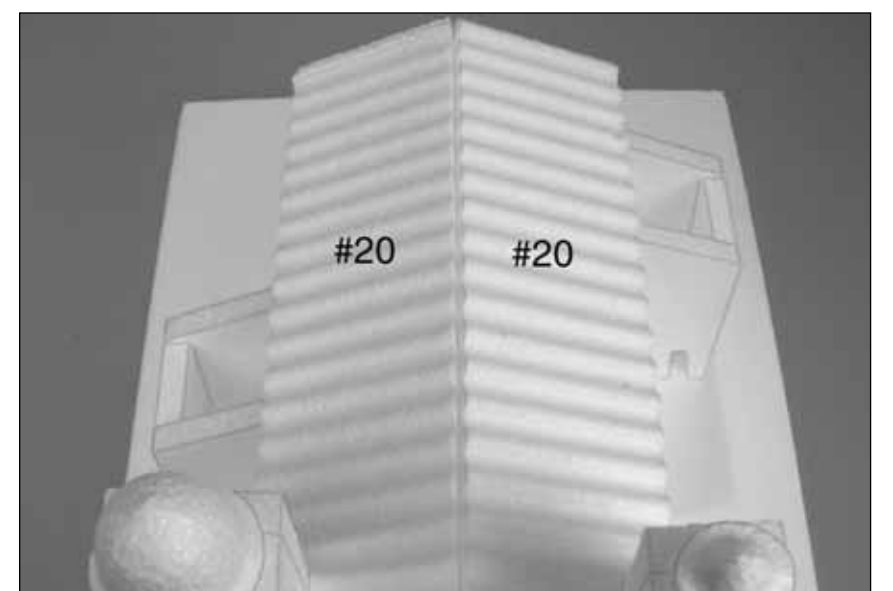
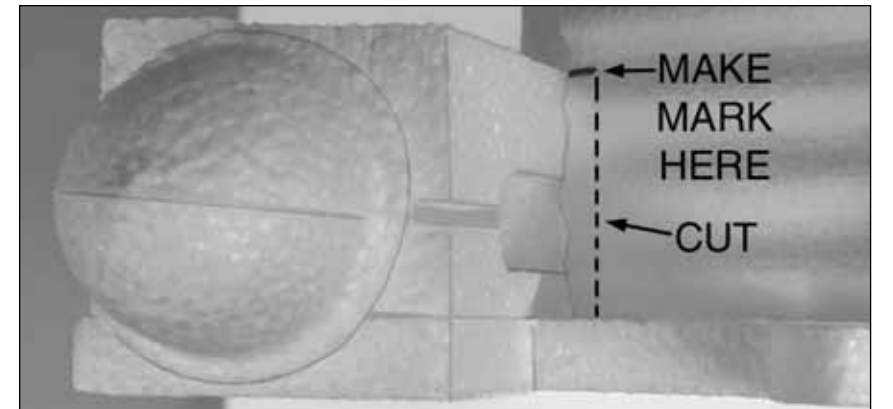
11. Glue the back room in place so that it is 1" from the rear of the main building.



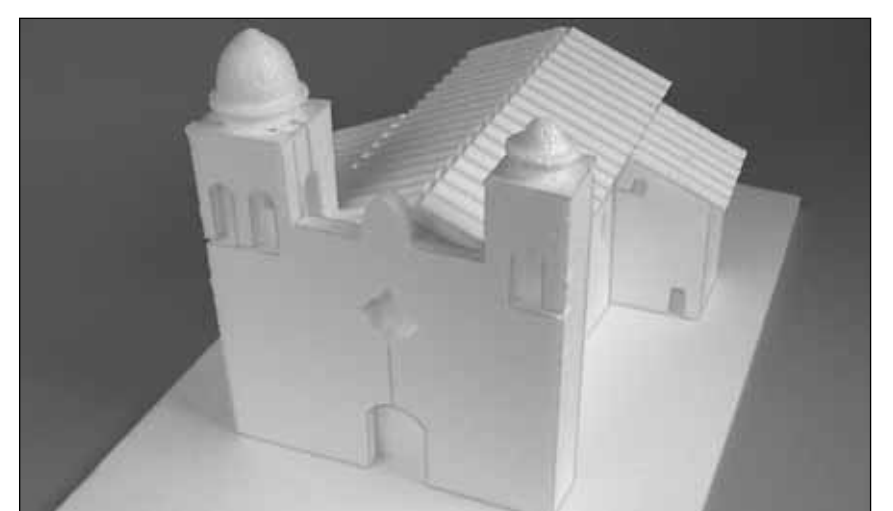
12. Glue the side room in place so that it is 5" from the rear of the main building.



13. Locate both pieces of #20. This is the roof of the main building. You will need to cut a small portion off of each piece so that it will fit tightly against the bell towers. Put one side of the roof in place and make a mark where the bell tower meets the roof. Using scissors, cut away about 1" of foam away between the mark and the front edge of the roof as shown below. Repeat this step for the other piece of roofing. Apply glue along the top edges of the main building and put the roof pieces in place.



14. Apply glue to the top edges of both the back room and the side room and put the #21 pieces in place as shown below.



## FINISHING

- When you paint your model, use only water-based paints.
- Check with your favorite hobby dealer for accessories such as grass, shrubbery, grave markers, figures...etc. that will add realism to your model.
