


# San Gabriel Archangel Instructions

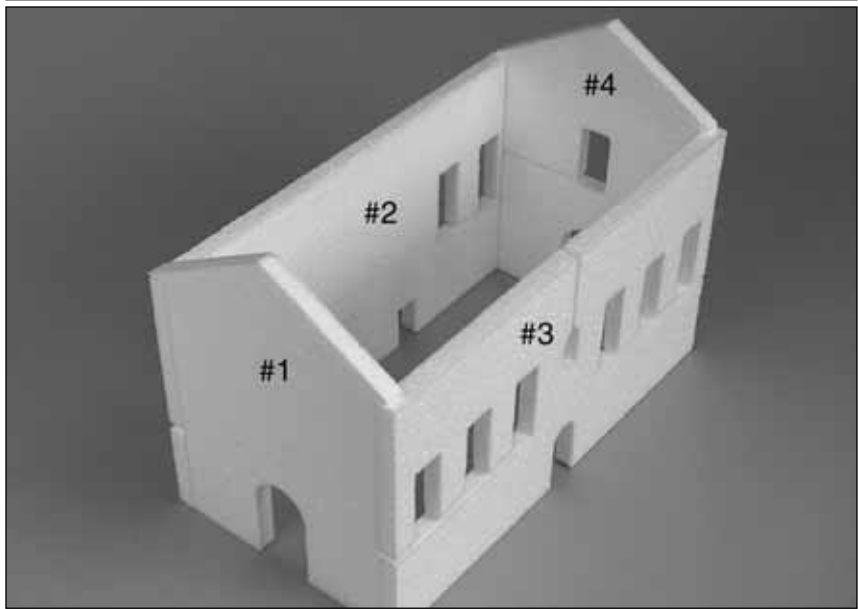
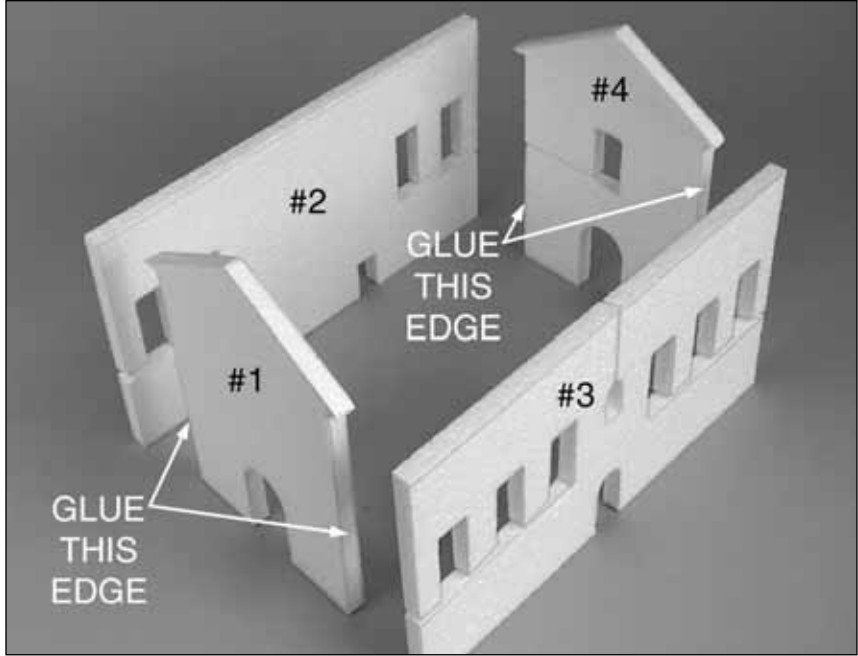
## Parts Drawing

- 
- Before starting assembly, read through each step of the instructions and carefully study each photo. As you put the model together, it is a good idea to "test" fit the pieces together before using any glue.
  - Spread out newspaper across the table or desk that you are working on. This will help to protect your work surface.
  - Use scissors to trim any pieces where needed. PARENTAL SUPERVISION is recommended.
  - Identify each piece of the model by matching it with the parts drawing above.
  - Assemble the model with standard white glue. It is a good idea to hold the pieces together with toothpicks until the glue is dry. Once the glue is dry, twist the toothpick and carefully pull it out.
  - Use a small brush, flat stick, or your finger to spread glue evenly on the surface.
  - Do not glue any of the pieces to the base until after the model is built.

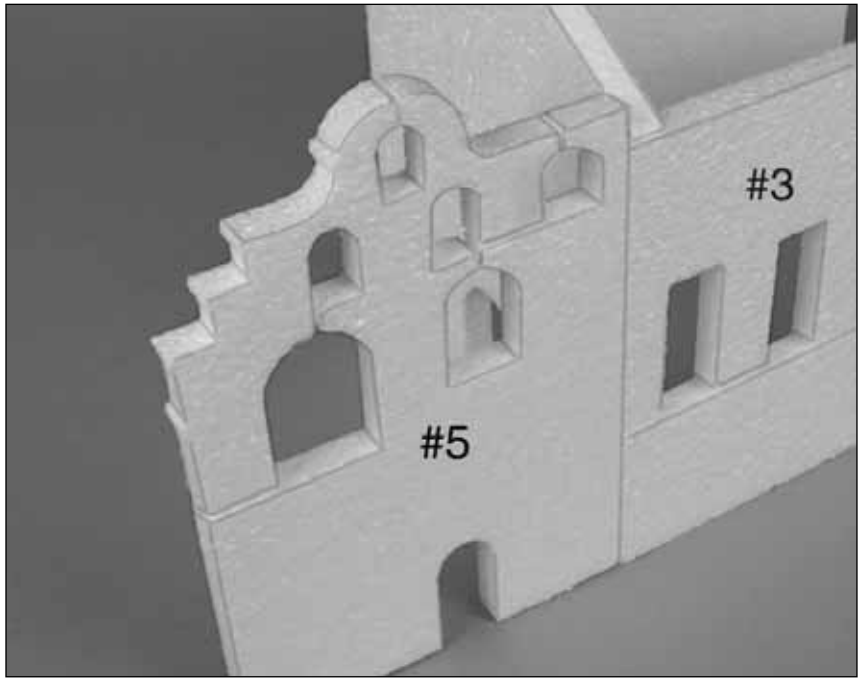
Note: The missions can either be assembled on the cardboard sheet (included) or on a sheet of foam (not included).

## ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

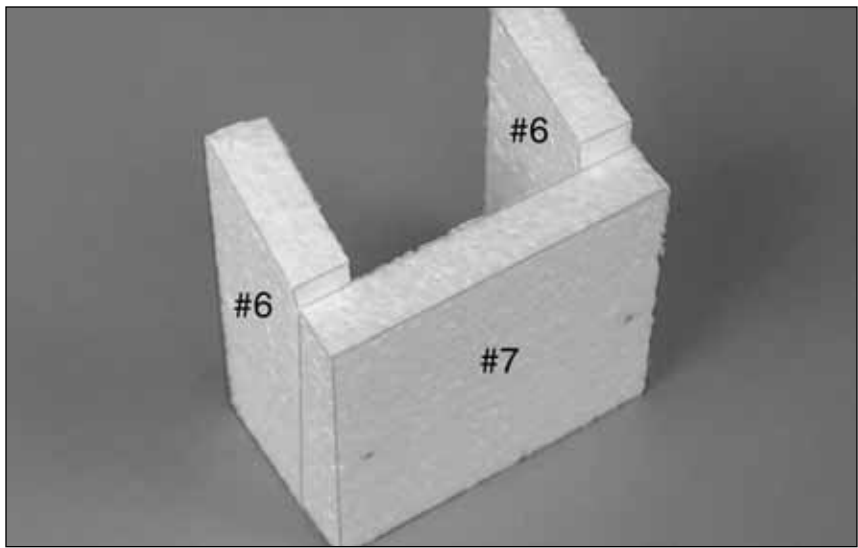
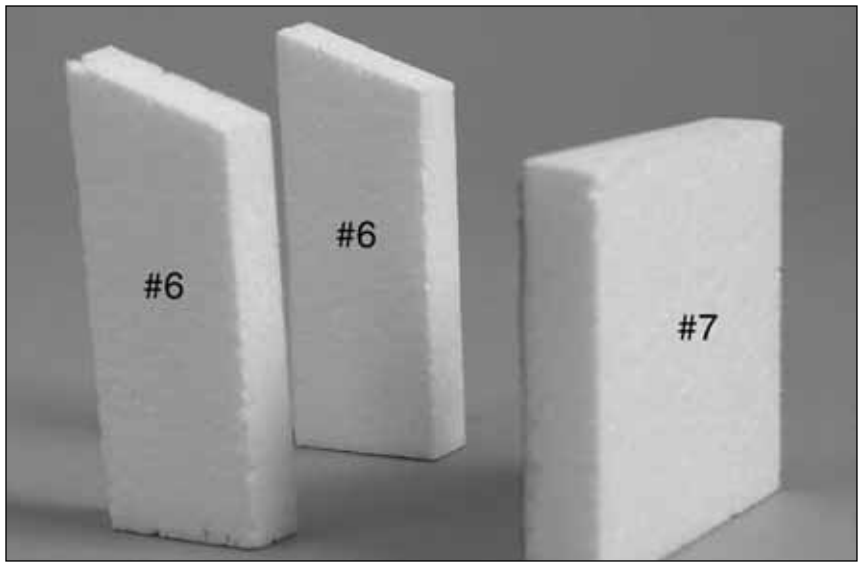
1. Place the 24" x 15" base on a clean, flat surface.
2. Apply glue along the side edges of #1 and #4 and put pieces #2 and #3 in place as shown. Make sure all edges meet evenly. This section is the "main building."



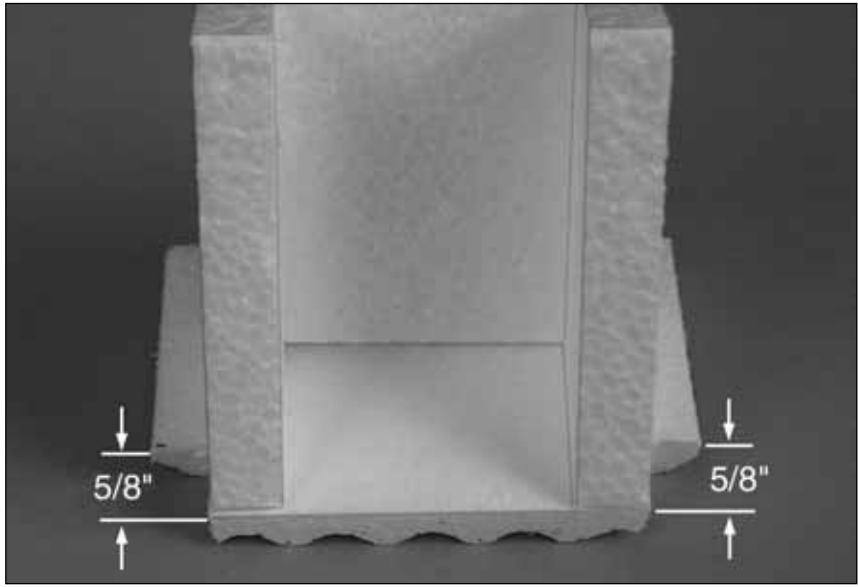
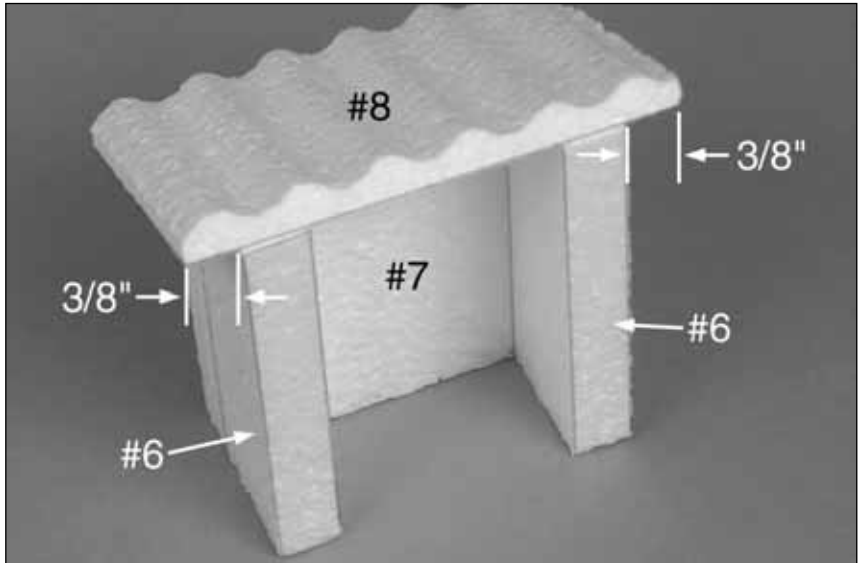
3. Glue #5 onto the right side of the #3 main building as shown.



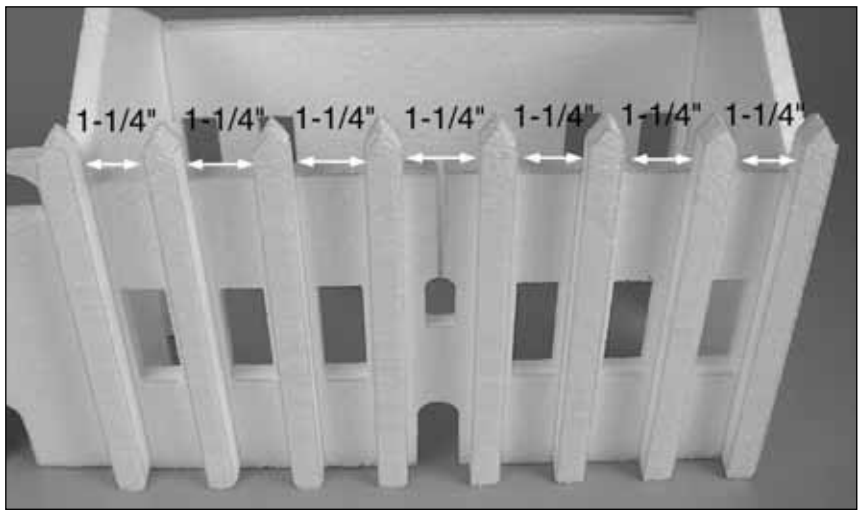
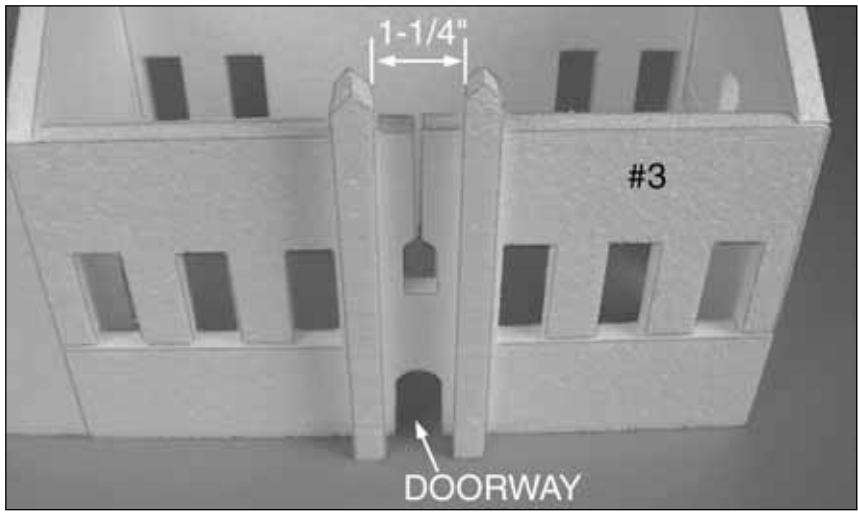
4. Locate both #6 sides and glue them to #7 as shown below, making sure that all of the edges meet evenly.



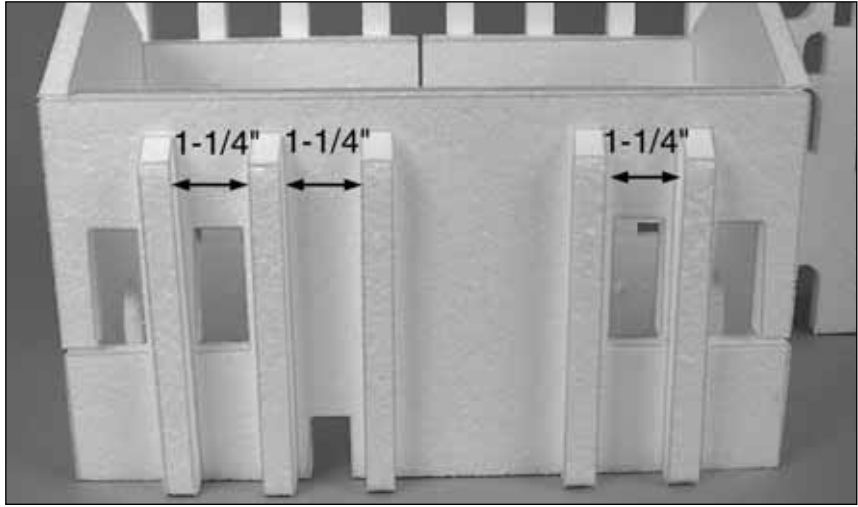
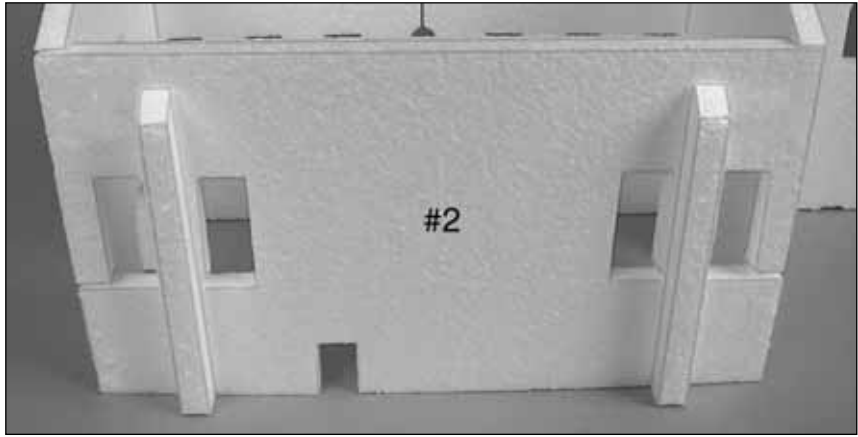
5. Glue #8 into place as shown below. Flip the section over and remove 5/8" from each side of the roof peak as shown.



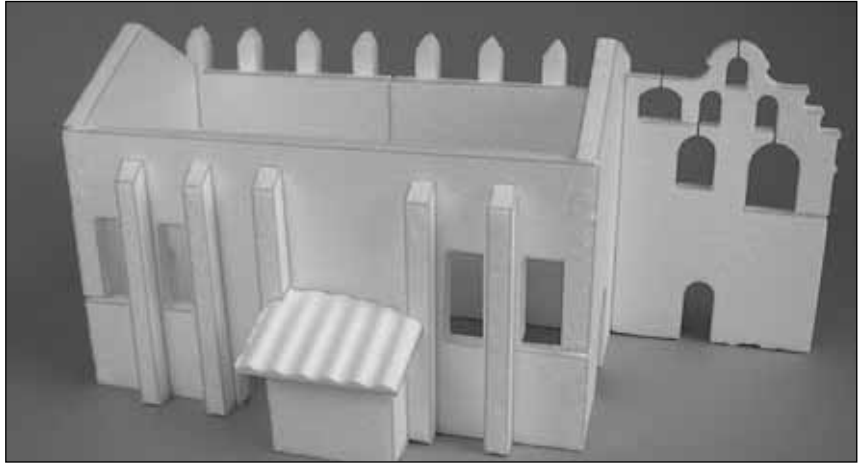
6. Glue eight of the #9 pieces onto #3 as shown below. Start by gluing one on each side of the doorway with 1-1/4" between them. Glue the rest in place with 1-1/4" between each column.



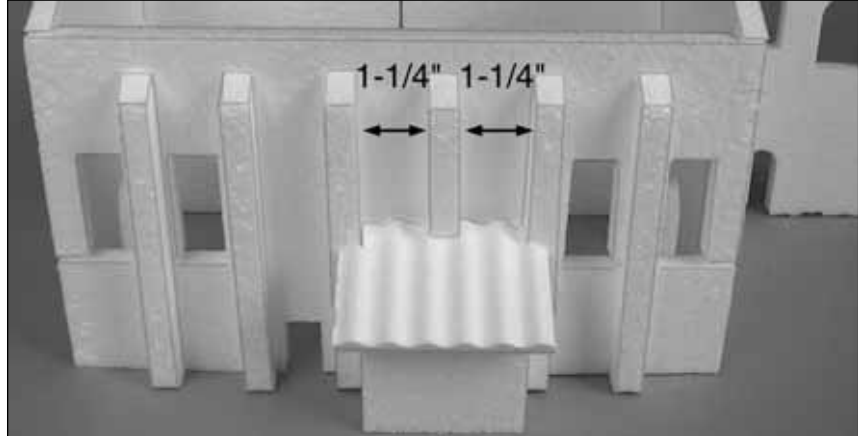
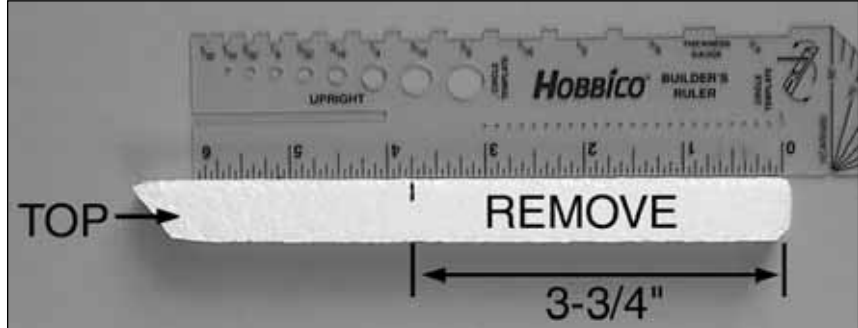
7. Glue five of the six #10 pieces onto #2 as shown in the two following photos. Start by gluing one in between each of the windows.



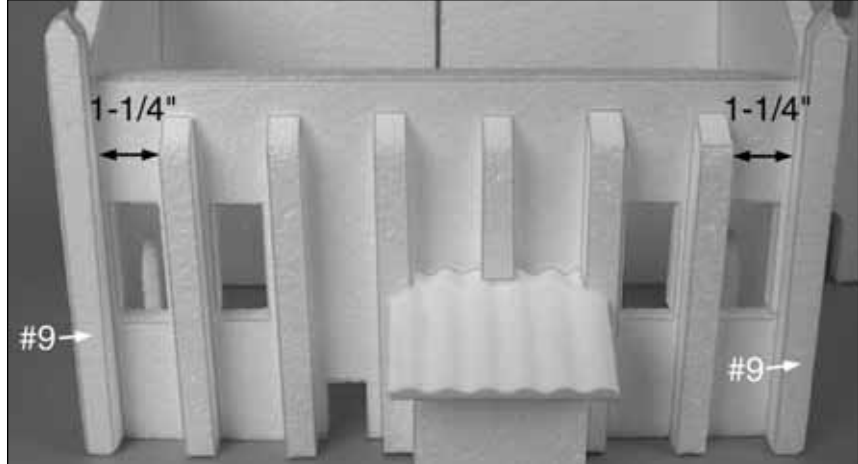
8. Glue the back room section to the main building.



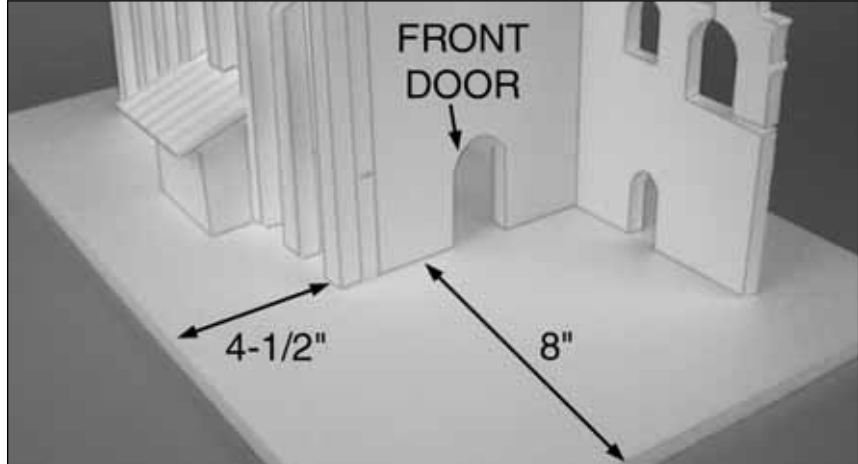
9. Remove 3-3/4" from the bottom of the remaining #10 piece and glue it into place as shown below. Keep in mind, there should be 1-1/4" on each side of the column.



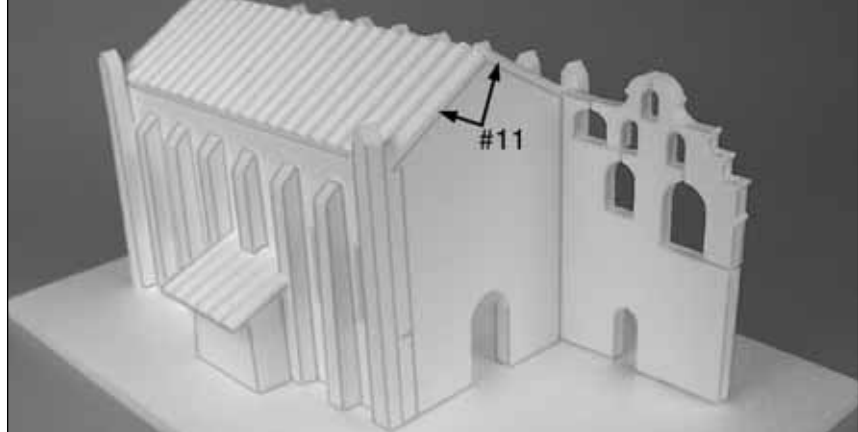
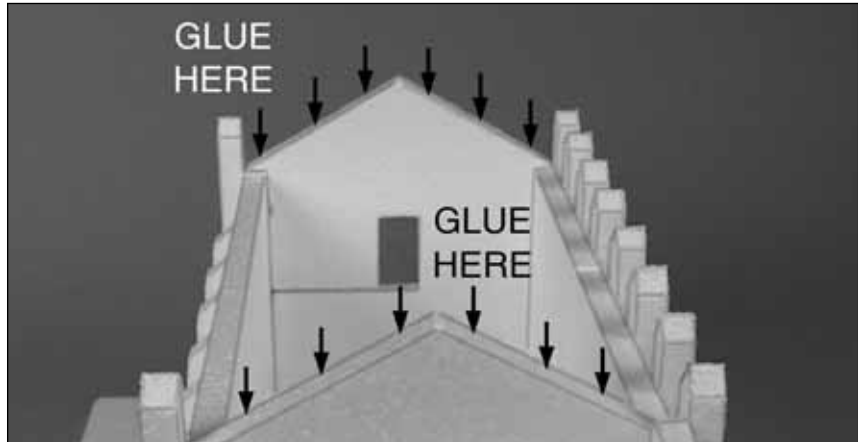
10. Glue the two remaining #9 pieces into place as shown, 1-1/4" from the columns.



11. Now the mission can be glued to the base. Glue the main building in place so that there is 8" from the front of the base to the front door. The left side of the main building should be about 4-1/2" from the edge of the base. This will leave you enough room to create scenery for your model.



12. Locate the two #11 pieces. This is the roof of the main building. Apply glue to the roofline edges and put the roof pieces in place.



## FINISHING

- When you paint your model, use only water-based paints.
- Check with your favorite hobby dealer for accessories such as grass, shrubbery, grave markers, figures...etc. that will add realism to your model.
