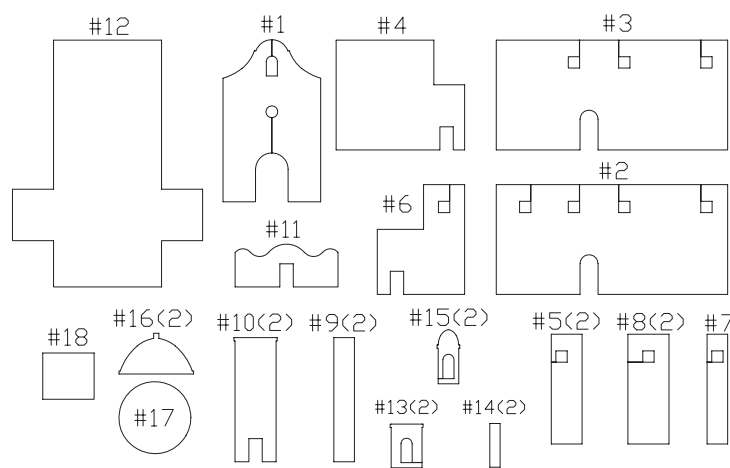


San Juan Capistrano Instructions

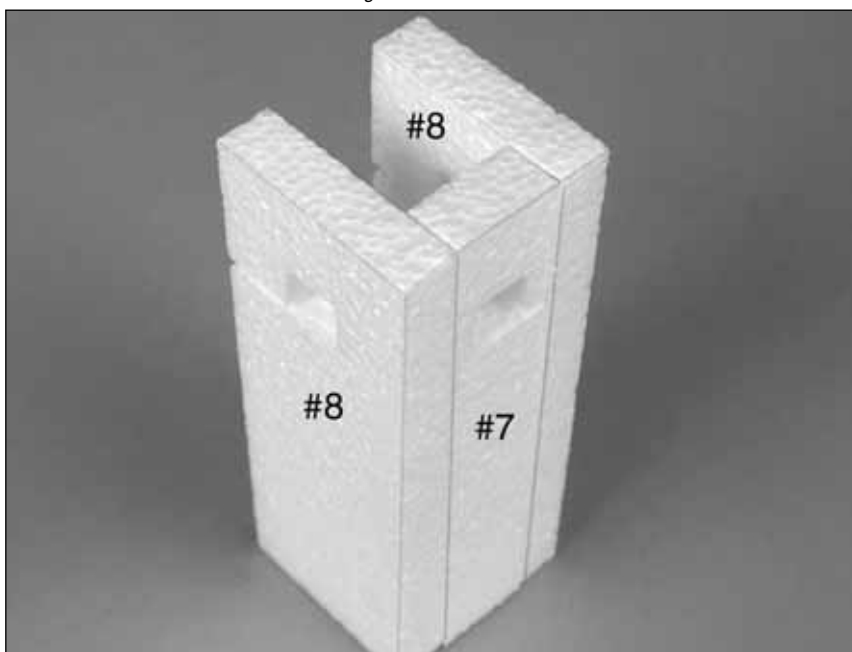
Parts Drawing



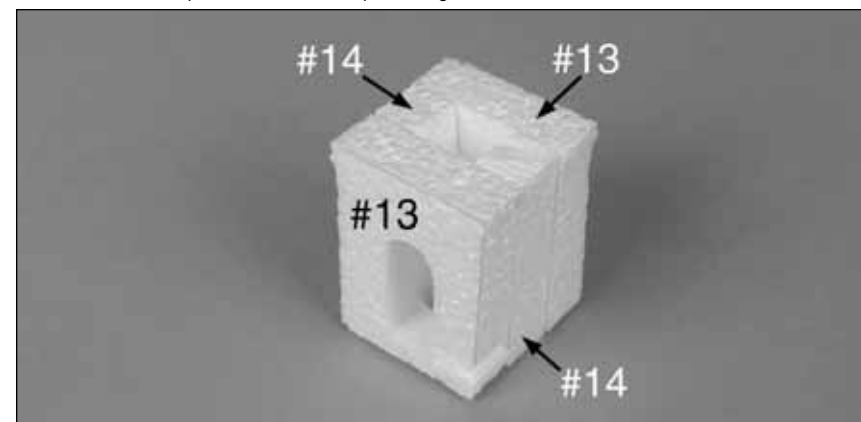
- Before starting assembly, read through each step of the instructions and carefully study each photo. As you put the model together, it is a good idea to "test" fit the pieces together before using any glue.
- Spread out newspaper across the table or desk that you are working on. This will help to protect your work surface.
- Use scissors to trim any pieces where needed. PARENTAL SUPERVISION is recommended.
- Identify each piece of the model by matching it with the parts drawing above.
- Assemble the model with standard white glue. It is a good idea to hold the pieces together with toothpicks until the glue is dry. Once the glue is dry, twist the toothpick and carefully pull it out.
- Use a small brush, flat stick, or your finger to spread glue evenly on the surface.
- Do not glue any of the pieces to the base until after Step 7 is completed.

Note: The missions can either be assembled on the cardboard sheet (included) or on a sheet of foam (not included).

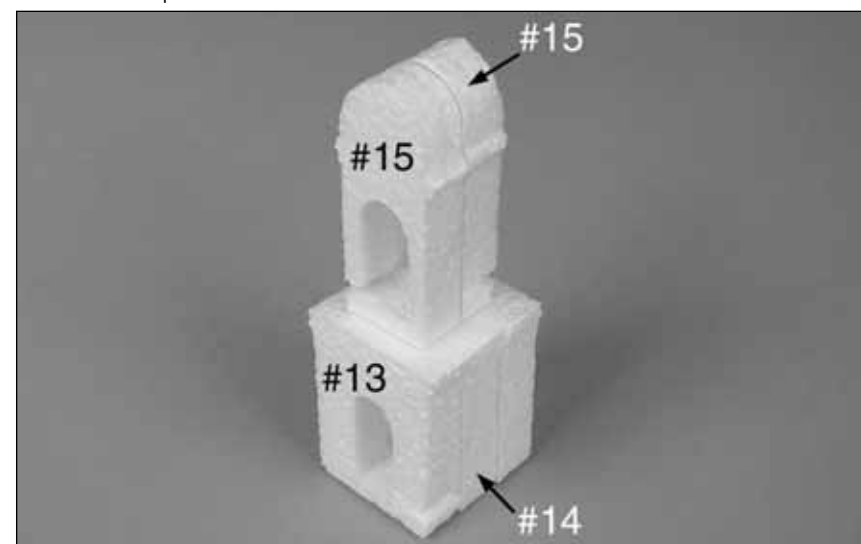
- 5. Glue #7 to both #8 pieces as shown. Make sure all edges meet evenly. Set this section aside for now. You will assemble it to the main building later.



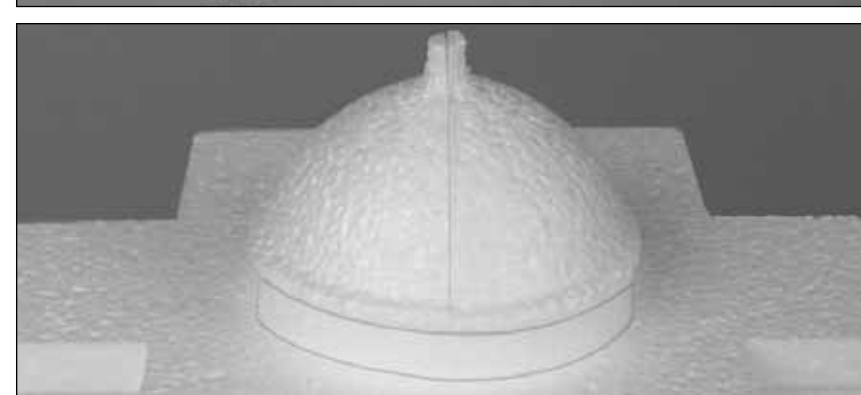
- 10. Glue both #13 pieces and both #14 pieces together as shown below.



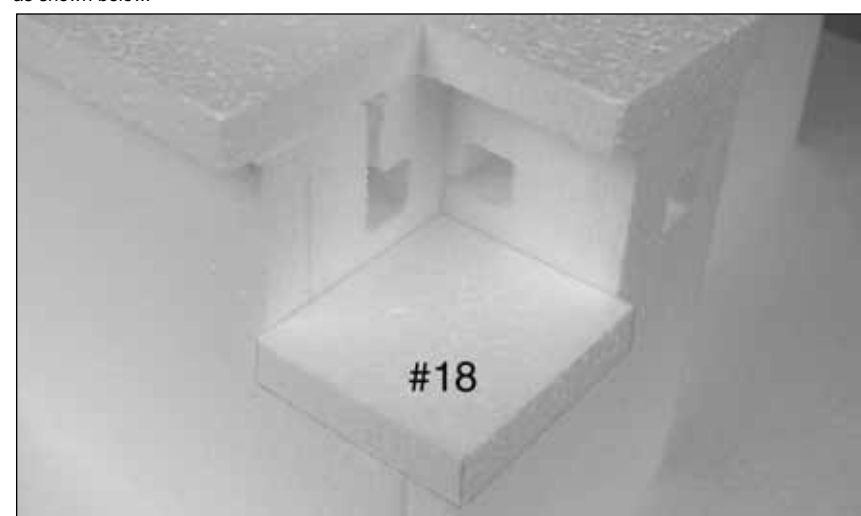
- 11. Glue both #15 pieces together and glue to the top of pieces #13 and #14. This is the top of the bell tower. Glue it into place as shown below.



- 12. Glue both #16 pieces together as shown below and then glue it to #17. This is the dome assembly. Glue it to the roof as shown.



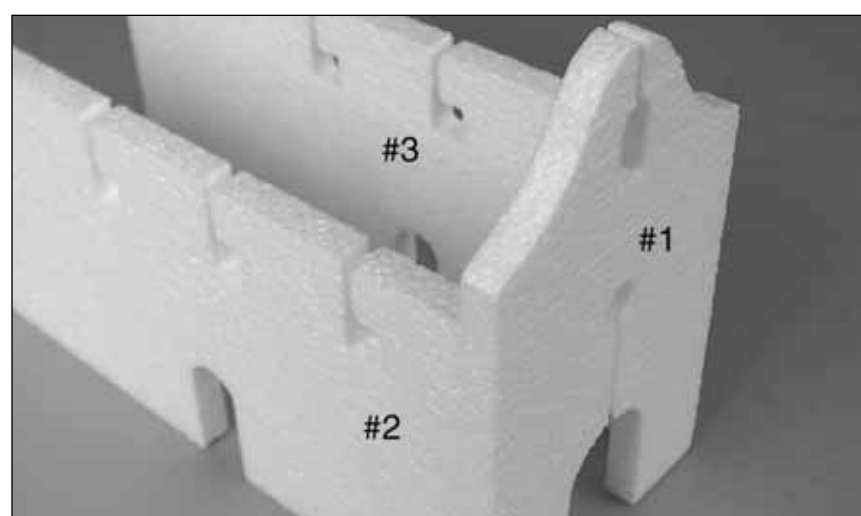
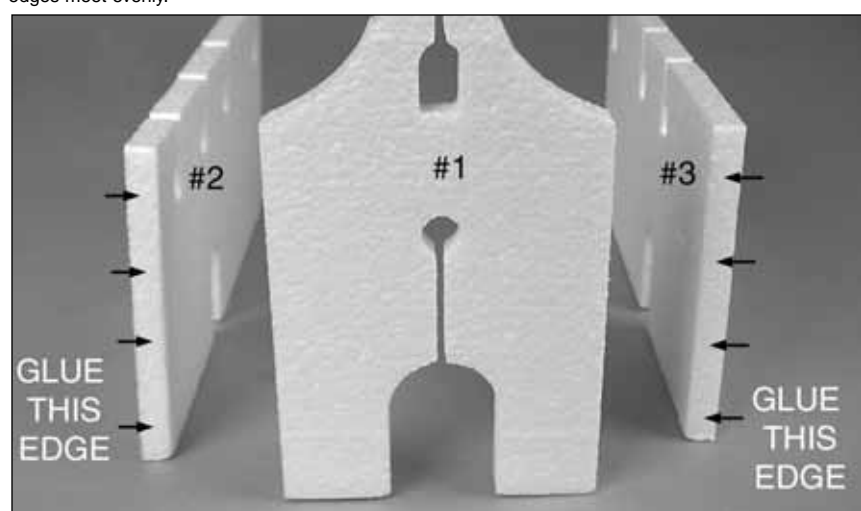
- 13. Locate piece #18. This is the roof of the small room at the rear of the main building. Glue it into place as shown below.



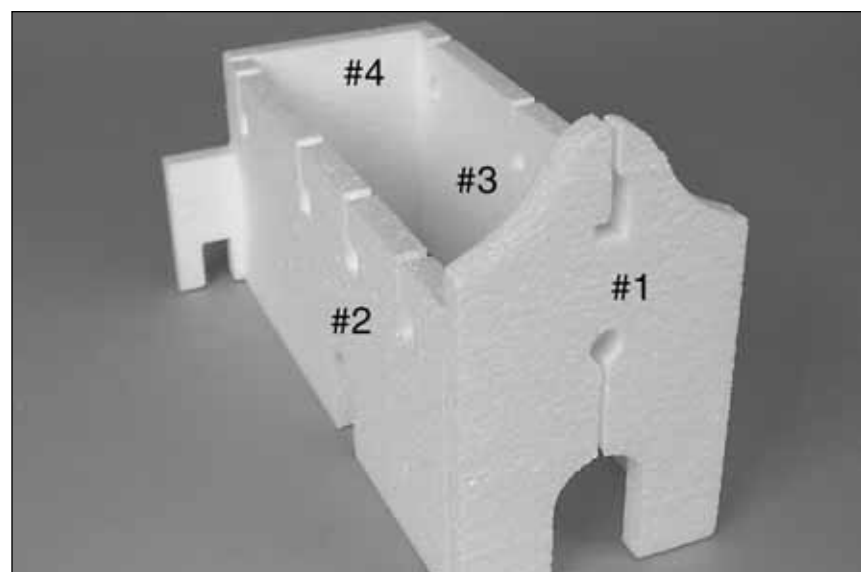
ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Place the 24" x 15" base on a clean, flat surface.

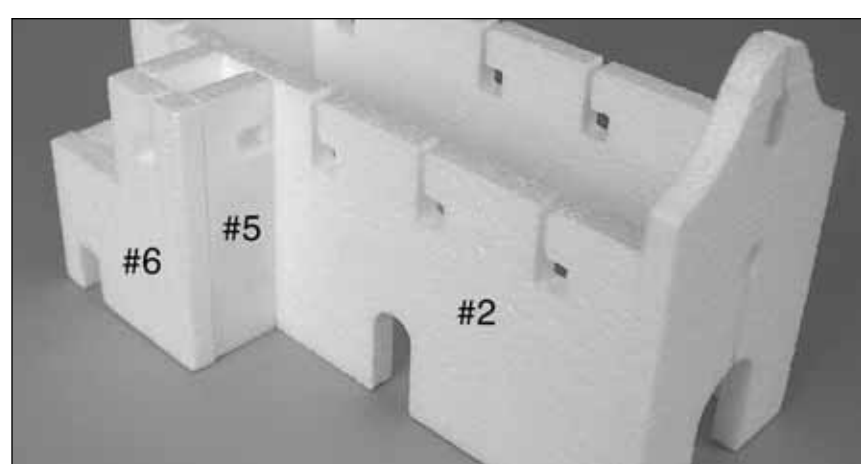
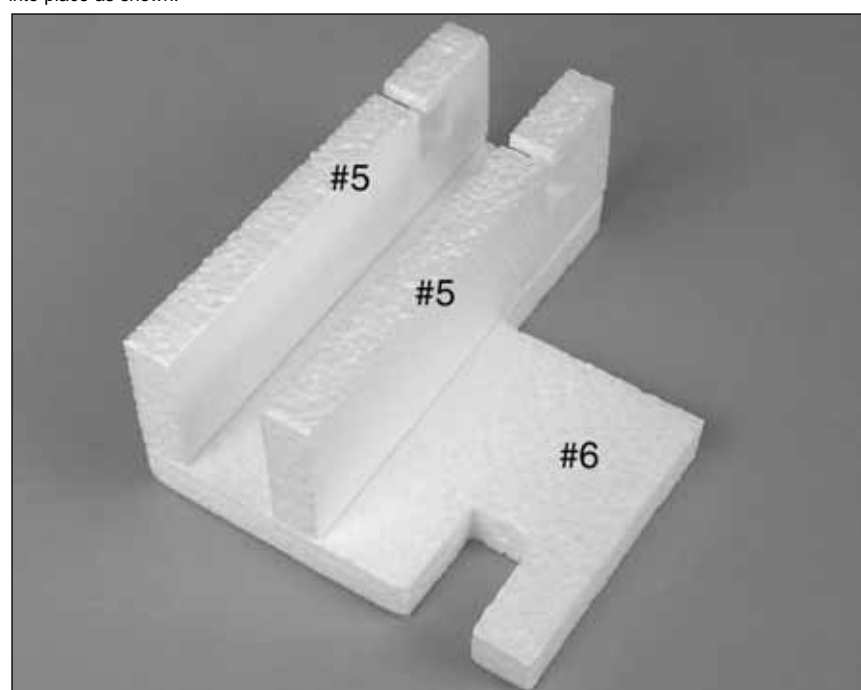
- 2. Apply glue along the front edge of #2 and #3. Place it against #1 as shown below. Make sure the edges meet evenly.



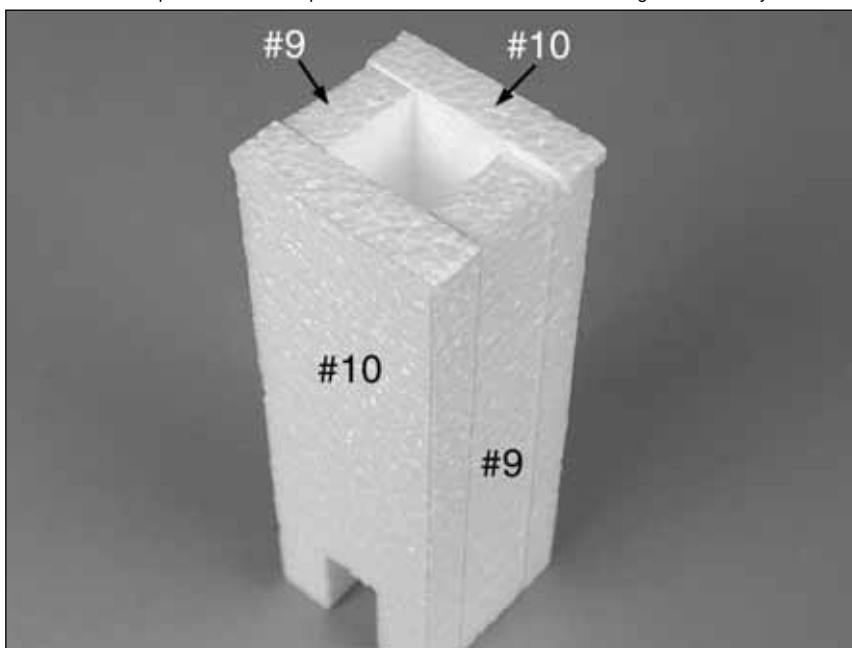
- 3. Apply glue on the rear edges of side #2 and side #3. Put #4 in place and line up the edges so they are even. The rear wall of #4 will stick out on the left side.



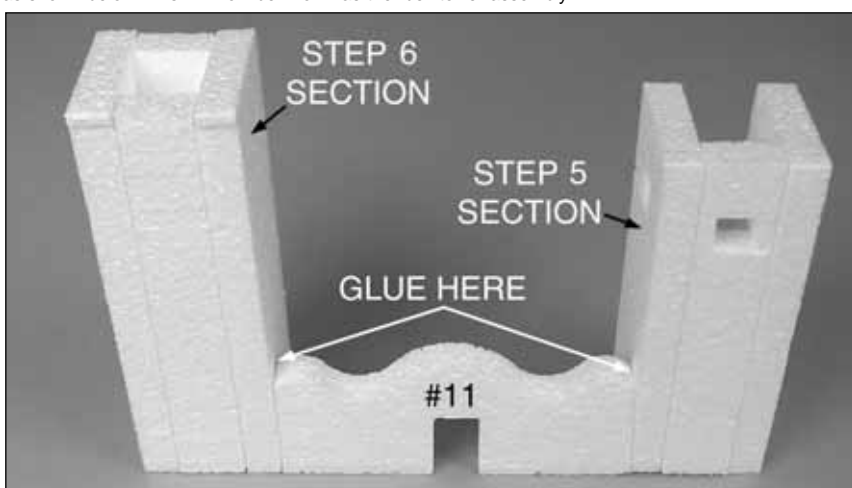
- 4. Glue both #5 pieces to #6 as shown below. Make sure the edges meet evenly. Now glue the section into place as shown.



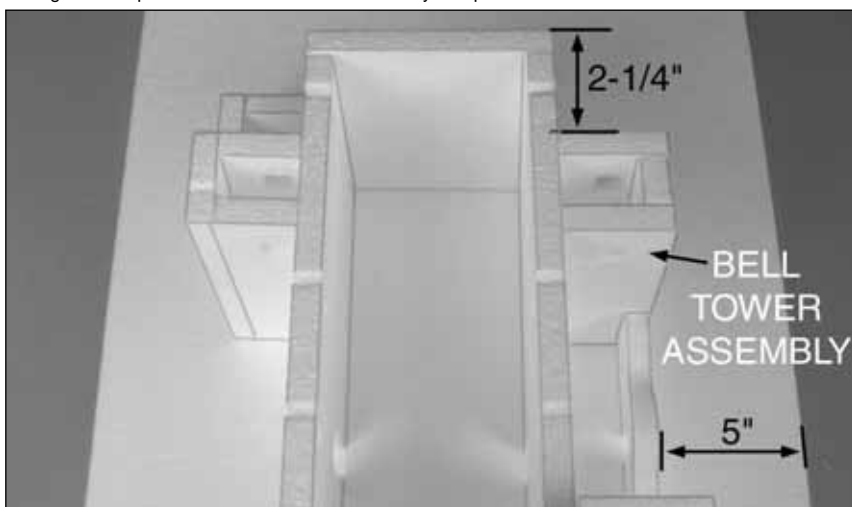
- 6. Glue both #9 pieces to both #10 pieces as shown below. Make sure the edges meet evenly.



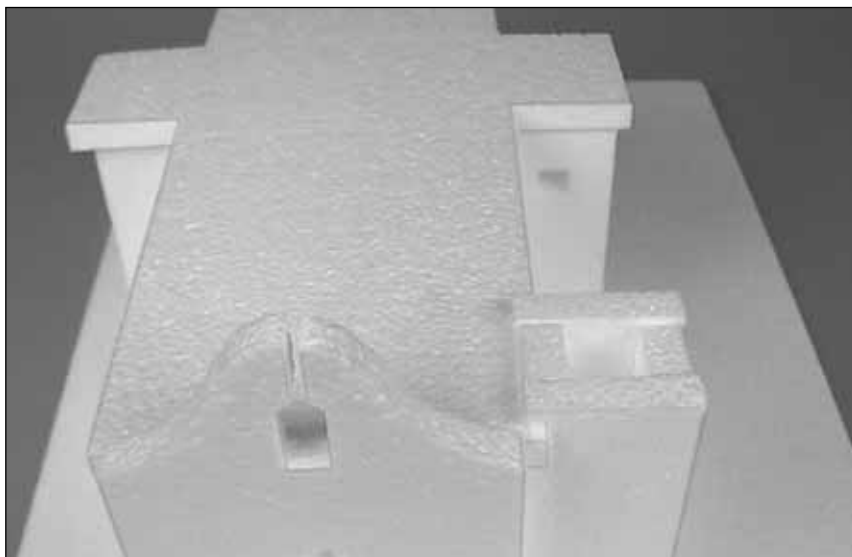
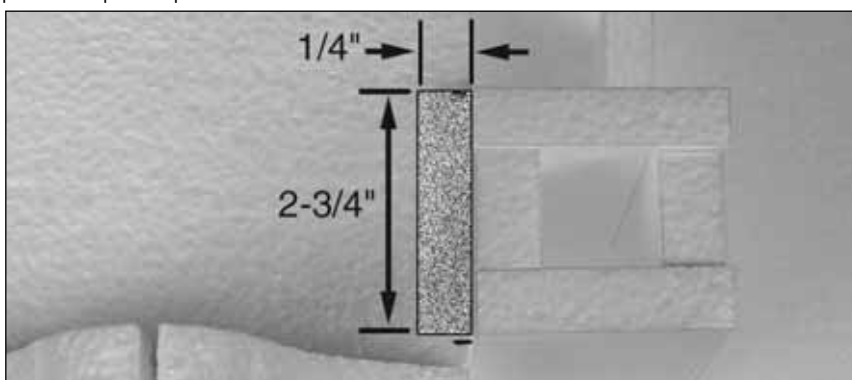
- 7. Apply glue to the front and rear edge of piece #11 and join the sections you built in steps 5 and 6 as shown below. This will now be known as the "bell tower assembly."



- 8. Now that the two basic sections of the mission are complete, the main building can be glued to the base. Glue the main building in place so that there is about 5" from the front of the base to the front door. The right side of the main building should be about 5" from the edge of the base. Measure 2-1/4" from the rear of the main building and make a mark as shown. This is where the rear of the bell tower assembly is to be glued into place. Glue the bell tower assembly into place as shown below.



- 9. Locate piece #12. This is the roof of the main building. The roof will stick out 1/4" on all sides. You will need to cut a small portion of the roof so that the front of the bell tower assembly will fit tightly. Put the roof in place and make two marks where the bell tower meets the roof. Using scissors, trim 1/4" of foam away between the two marks as shown below. Apply glue along the top edges of the main building and put the roof piece in place.



FINISHING



- When you paint your model, use only water-based paints.
- Check with your favorite hobby dealer for accessories such as grass, shrubbery, grave markers, figures...etc. that will add realism to your model.
