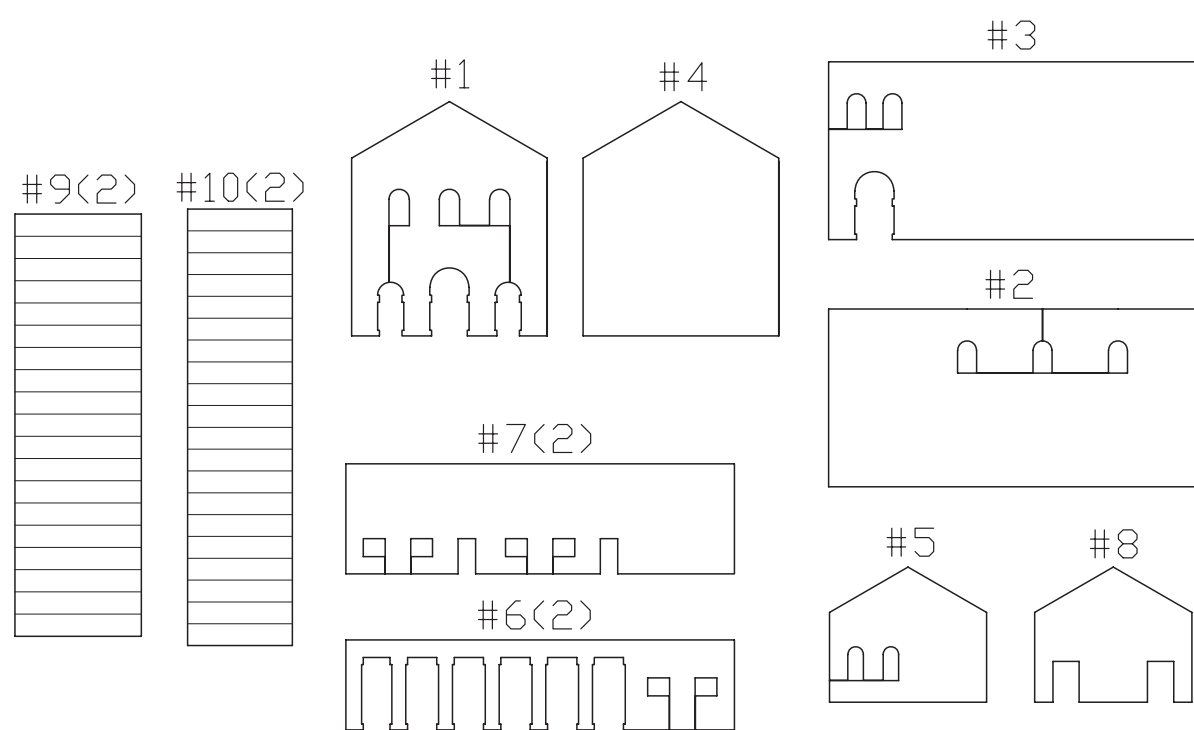


San Luis Obispo de Toloso Instructions

Parts Drawing



• Before starting assembly, read through each step of the instructions and carefully study each photo. As you put the model together, it is a good idea to "test" fit the pieces together before using any glue.

• Spread out newspaper across the table or desk that you are working on. This will help to protect your work surface.

• Use scissors to trim any pieces where needed. PARENTAL SUPERVISION is recommended.

• Identify each piece of the model by matching it with the parts drawing above.

• Assemble the model with standard white glue. It is a good idea to hold the pieces together with toothpicks until the glue is dry. Once the glue is dry, twist the toothpick and carefully pull it out.

• Use a small brush, flat stick, or your finger to spread glue evenly on the surface.

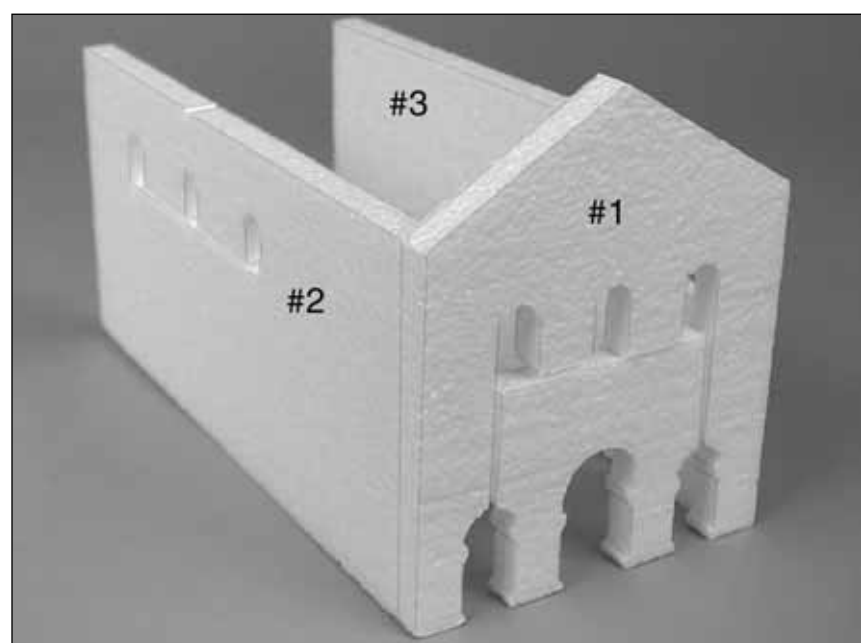
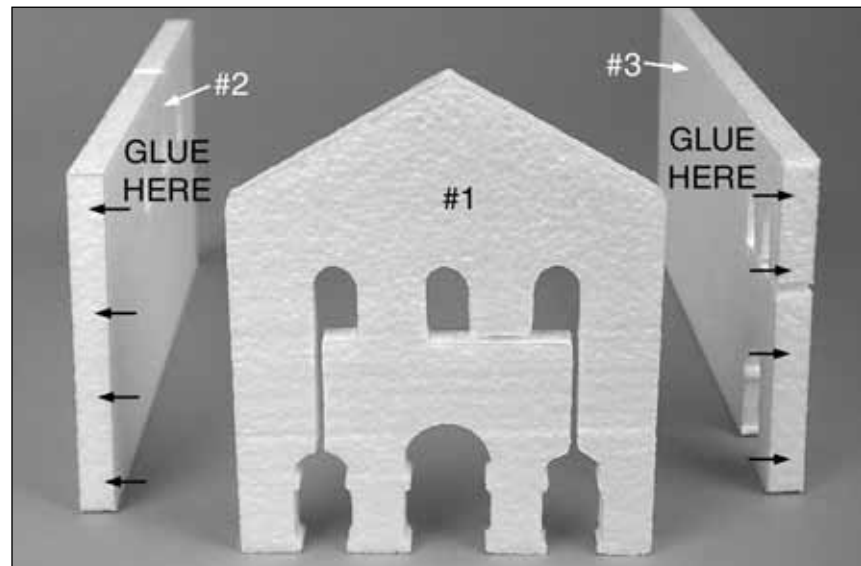
• Do not glue any of the pieces to the base until after Step 6 is completed.

Note: The missions can either be assembled on the cardboard sheet (included) or on a sheet of foam (not included).

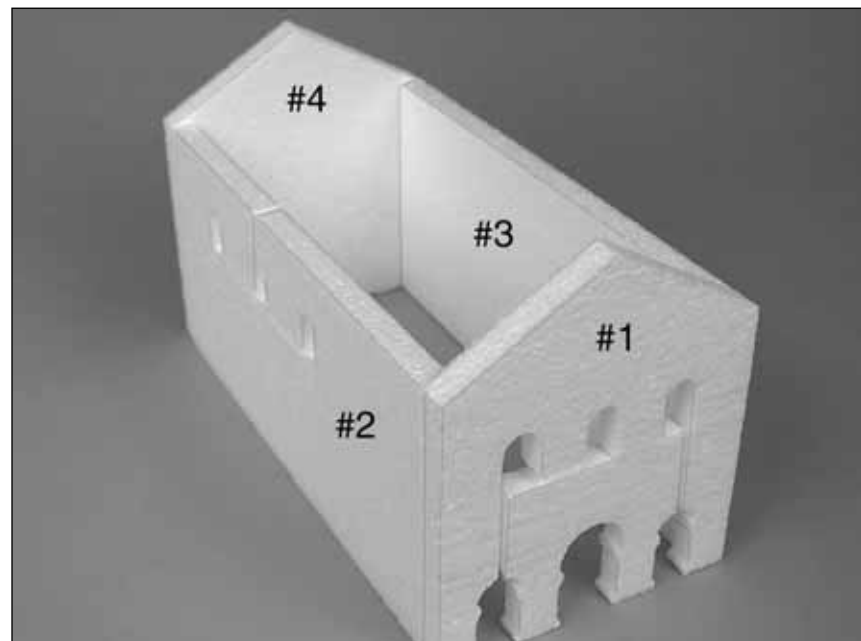
ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

□ 1. Place the 24" x 15" base on a clean, flat surface.

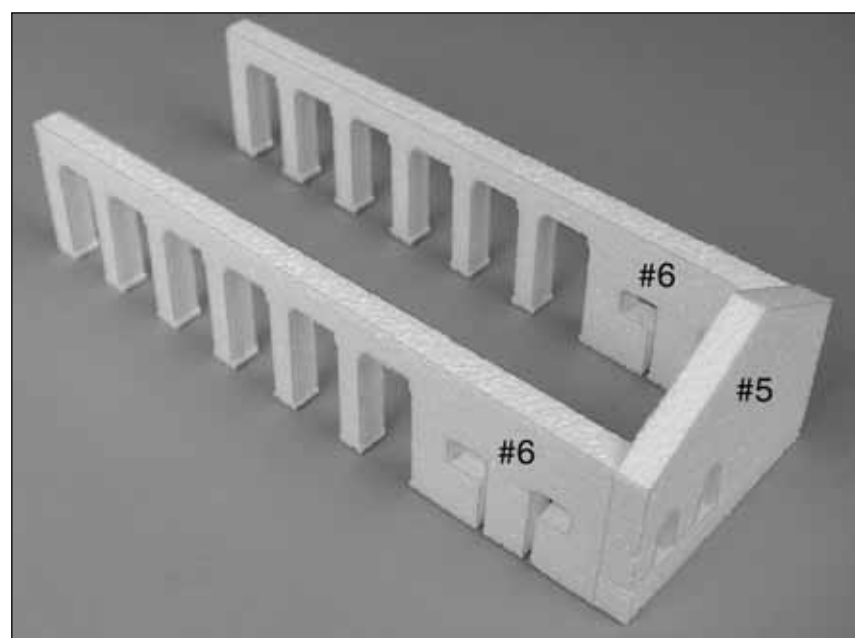
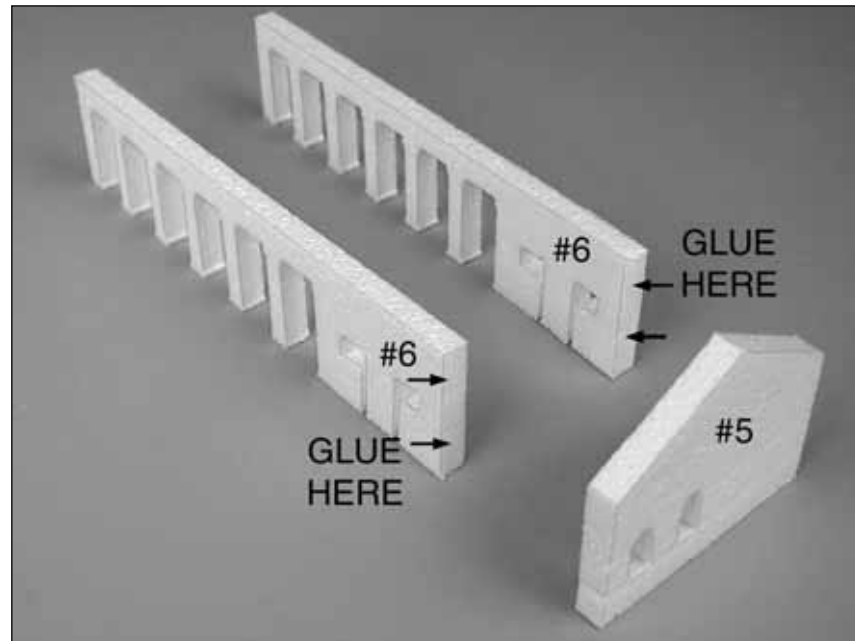
□ 2. Apply glue along the front edges of #2, #3 and place it against #1 as shown below. Make sure the edges meet evenly. Note the position of the doors and windows.



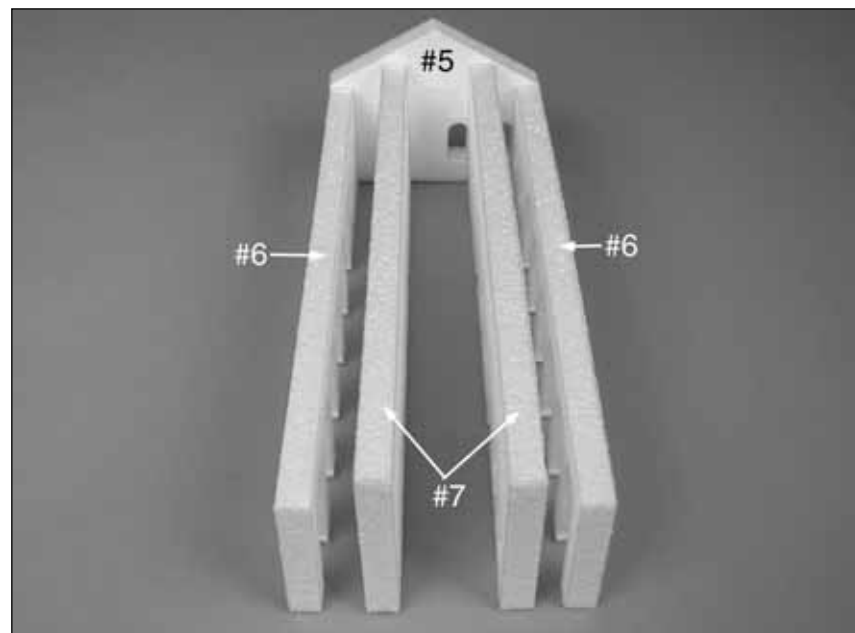
□ 3. Apply glue on the rear edges of #2 and #3. Put #4 in place and line up the edges so they are even. This section will be called the "main building."



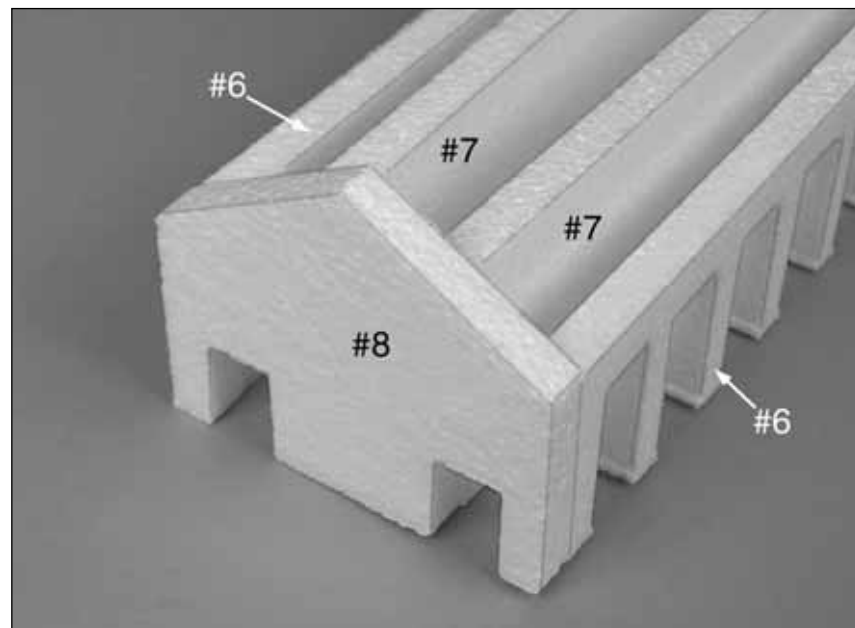
□ 4. Glue both #6 pieces to #5 as shown below, making sure that all of the edges meet evenly.



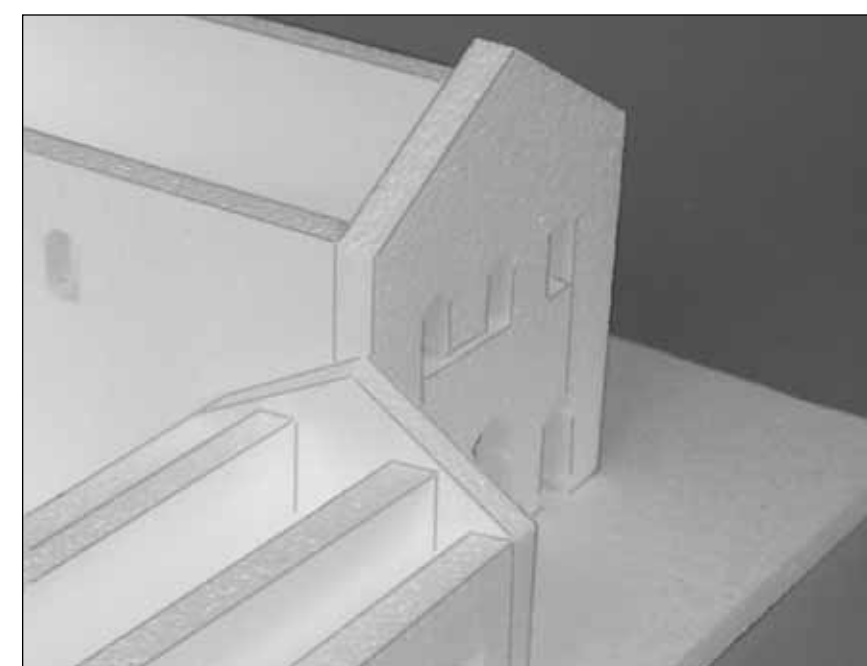
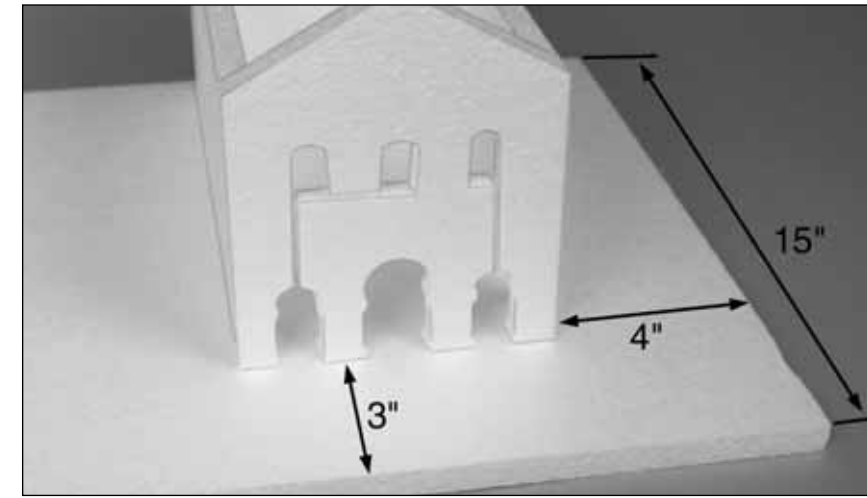
□ 5. Locate both #7 pieces and glue them to #5 as shown below.



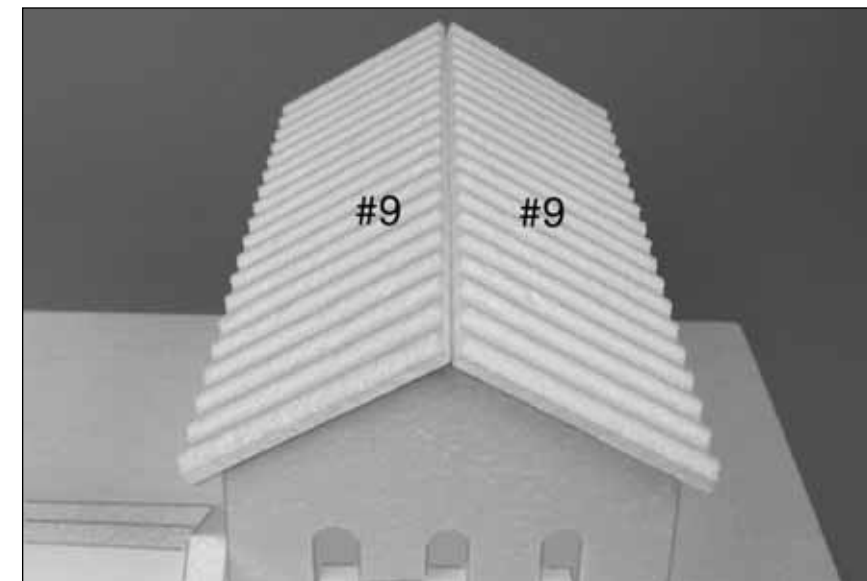
□ 6. Apply glue to the edges of both of the #6, #7 pieces, and place #8 against them as shown. This section will be called the "quarters."



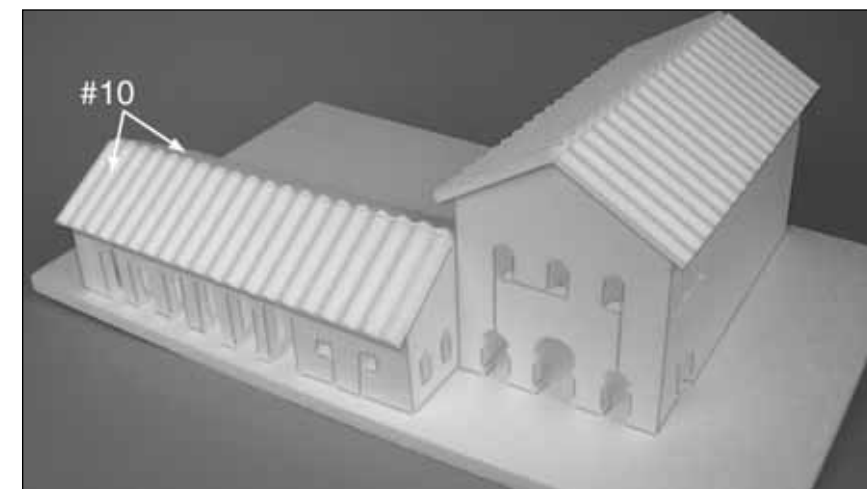
□ 7. Now that the two basic sections of the mission are complete, the main building can be glued to the base. Glue the main building in place so that there is about 3" from the front of the base to the front door. The right side of the main building should be about 4" from the edge of the base. Glue the quarters in place so that the peak of the roof is even with the left side of the main building as shown below. This will leave you enough room to create scenery for your model.



□ 8. Locate both pieces of #9. This is the roof of the main building. Apply glue to the roofline edges and put the roof pieces in place.



□ 9. Locate both pieces of #10. This is the roof of the quarters. Apply glue to the roofline edges and put the roof pieces in place.



FINISHING

- When you paint your model, use only water-based paints.
- Check with your favorite hobby dealer for accessories such as grass, shrubbery, grave markers, action figures...etc. that will add realism to your model.
