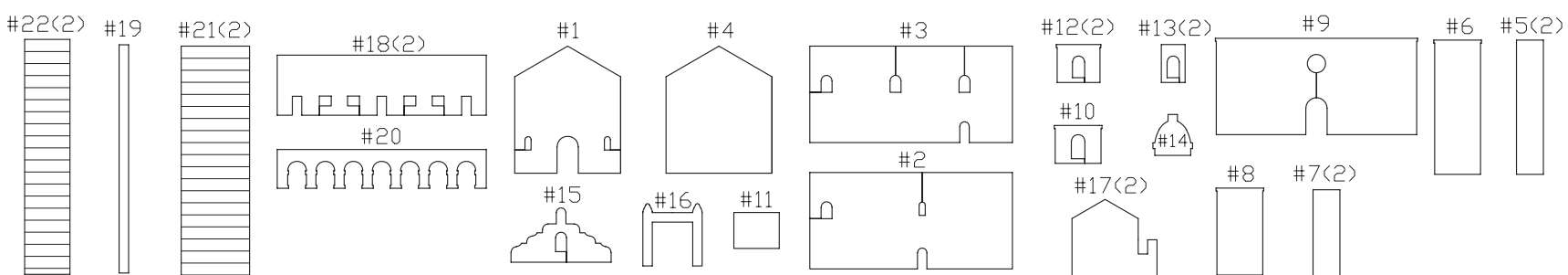


Mission San Luis Rey Instructions

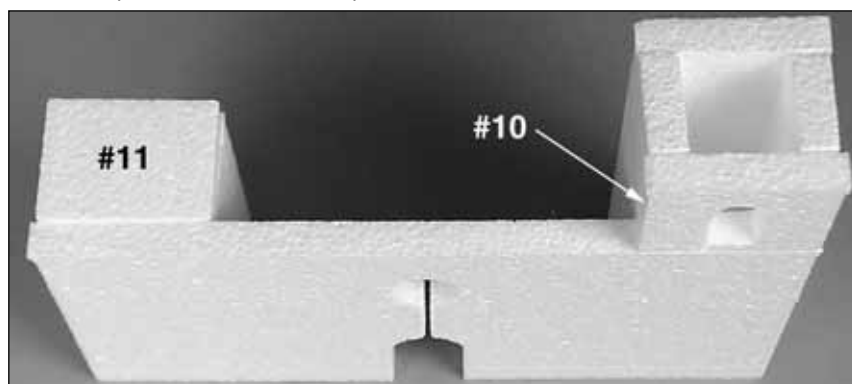
Parts Drawing



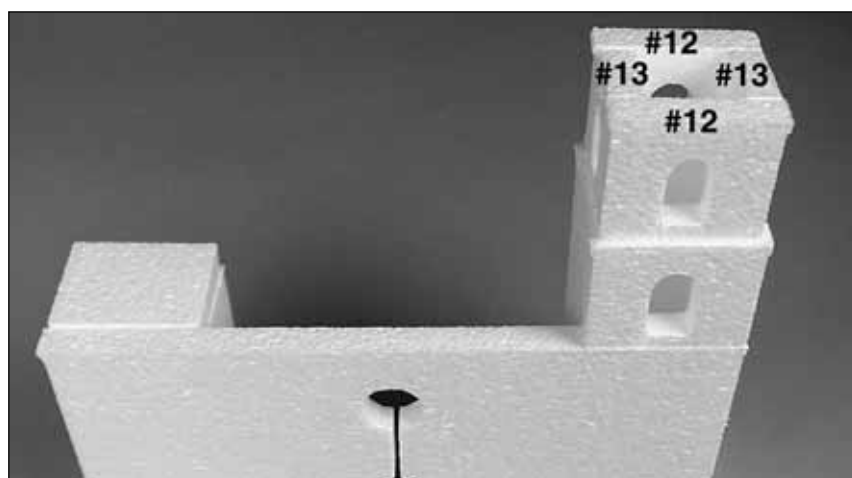
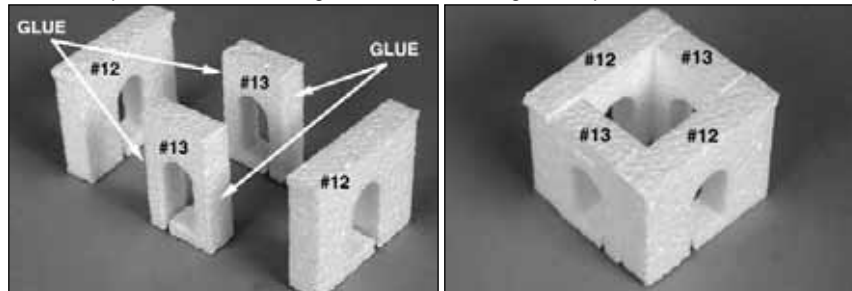
- Before starting assembly, read through each step of the instructions and carefully study each photo. As you put the model together, it is a good idea to "test" fit the pieces together before using any glue.
- Spread out newspaper across the table or desk that you are working on. This will help to protect your work surface.
- Use scissors to trim any pieces where needed. PARENTAL SUPERVISION is recommended.
- Identify each piece of the model by matching it with the parts drawing above.
- Assemble the model with standard white glue. It is a good idea to hold the pieces together with toothpicks until the glue is dry. Once the glue is dry, twist the toothpick and carefully pull it out.
- Use a small brush, flat stick, or your finger to spread glue evenly on the surface.
- Do not glue any of the pieces to the base until after Step 12 is completed.

Note: The missions can either be assembled on the cardboard sheet (included) or on a sheet of foam (not included).

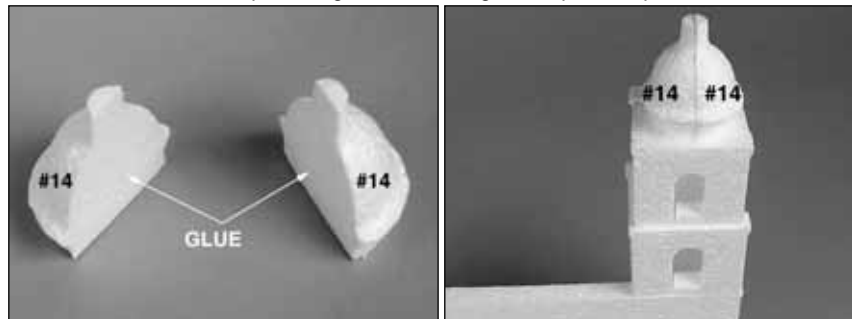
- 6. Glue pieces #10 and #11 into place as shown.



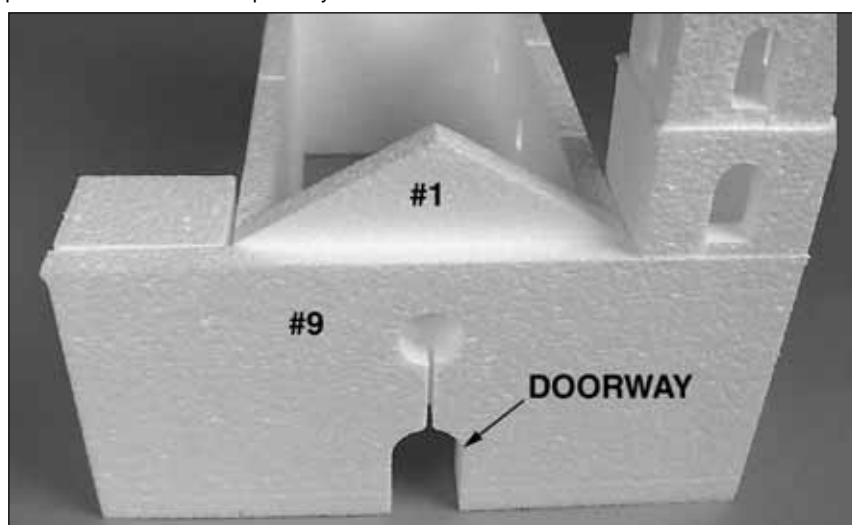
- 7. Glue pieces #12 and #13 together as shown and glue into place on the bell tower.



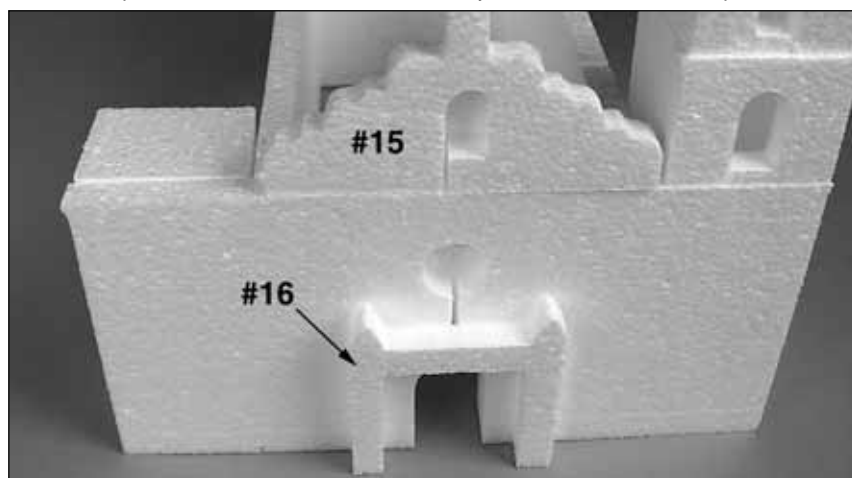
- 8. Glue both #14 dome pieces together and then glue into place atop the bell tower.



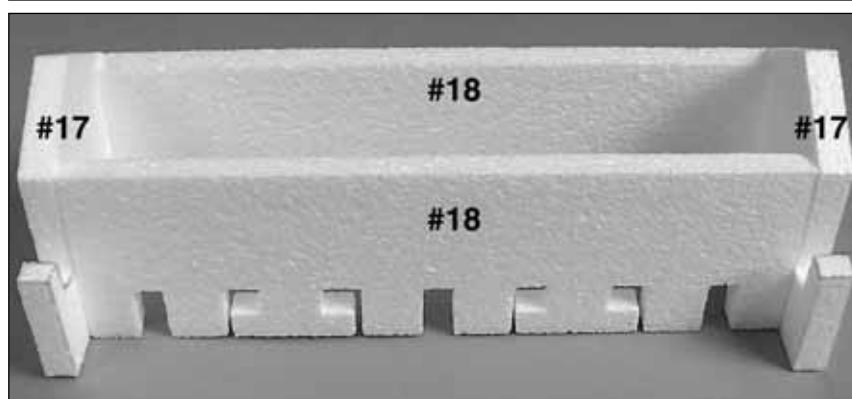
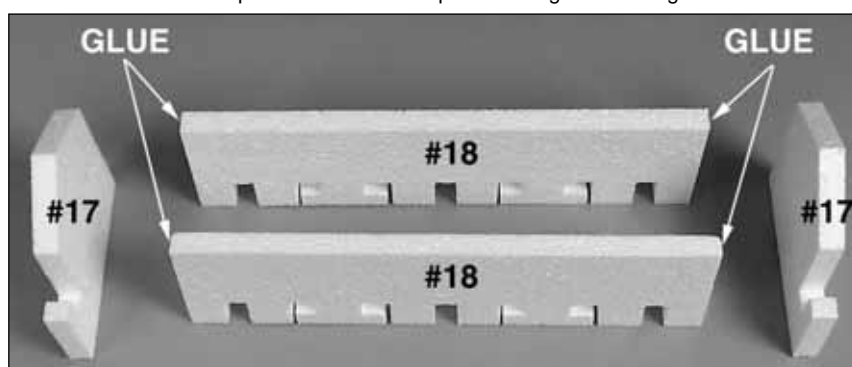
- 9. Glue the bell tower assembly to the main building as shown so that the doorways on pieces #1 and #9 match up evenly.



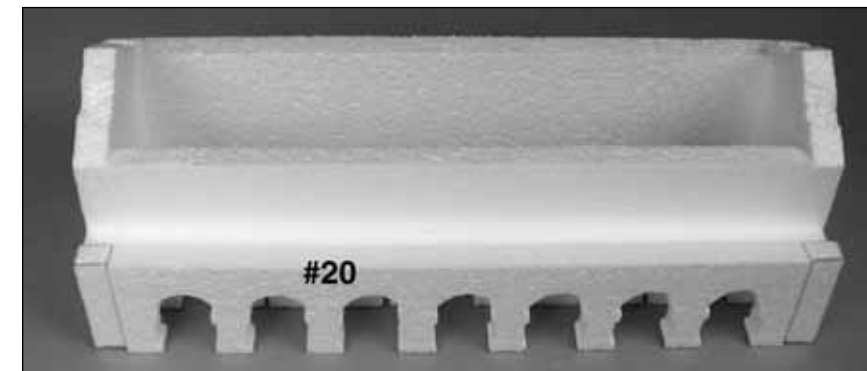
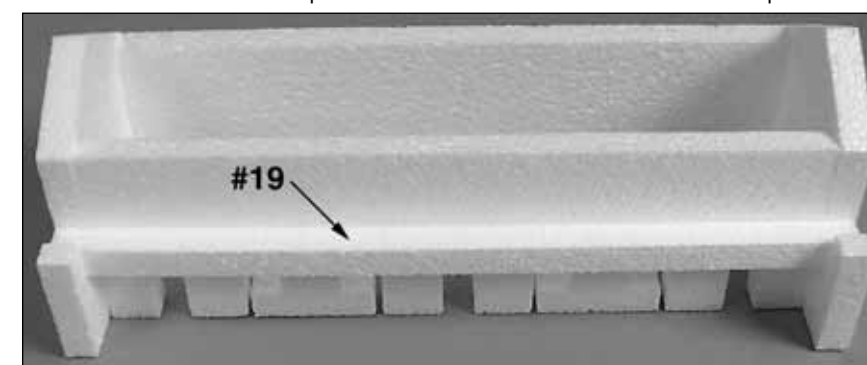
- 10. Glue pieces #15 and #16 onto #9 so that they are as close to center as possible.



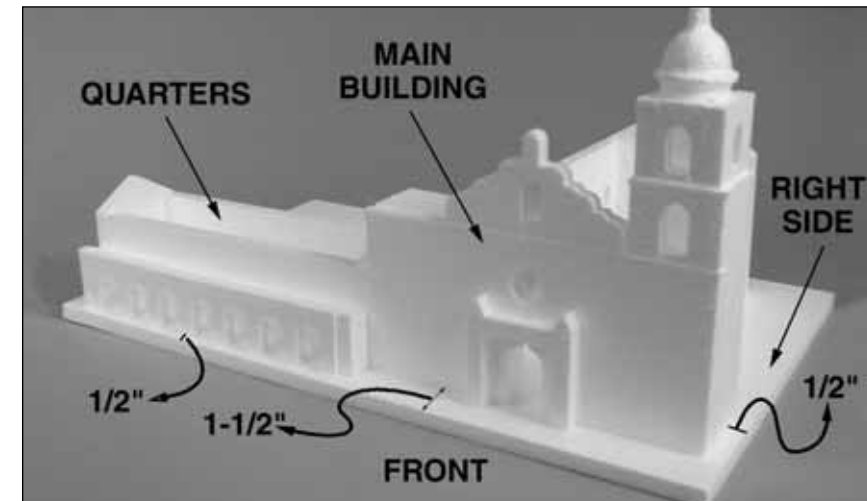
- 11. Locate both #17 pieces and both #18 pieces and glue them together as shown.



- 12. Glue #19 and #20 into place as shown. This section will be called the "quarters."



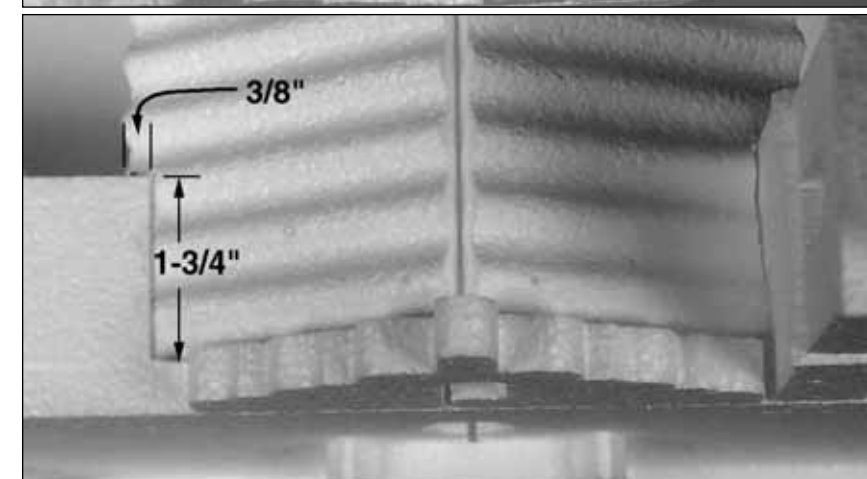
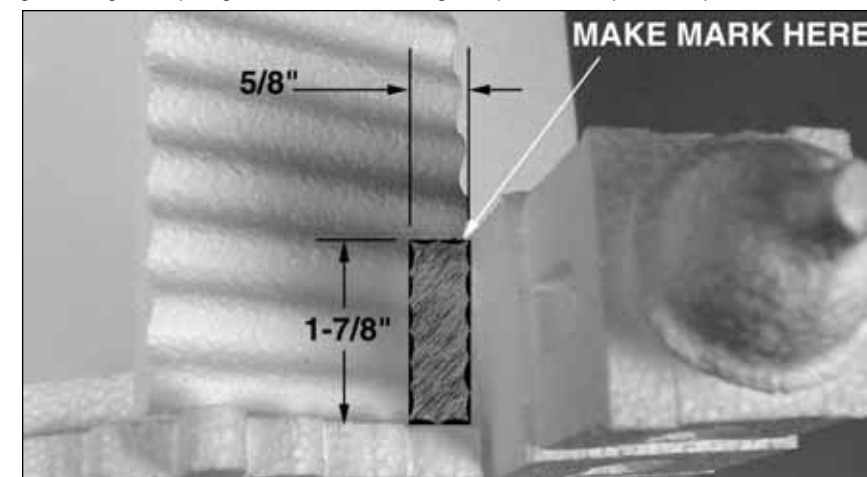
- 13. Now that the basic sections are complete, they can now be glued to the base. Glue the main building in place so that there is 1-1/2" from the front of the base to the front door. The right side of the main building should be 1/2" from the edge of the base. This will leave you enough room to create scenery for your model.



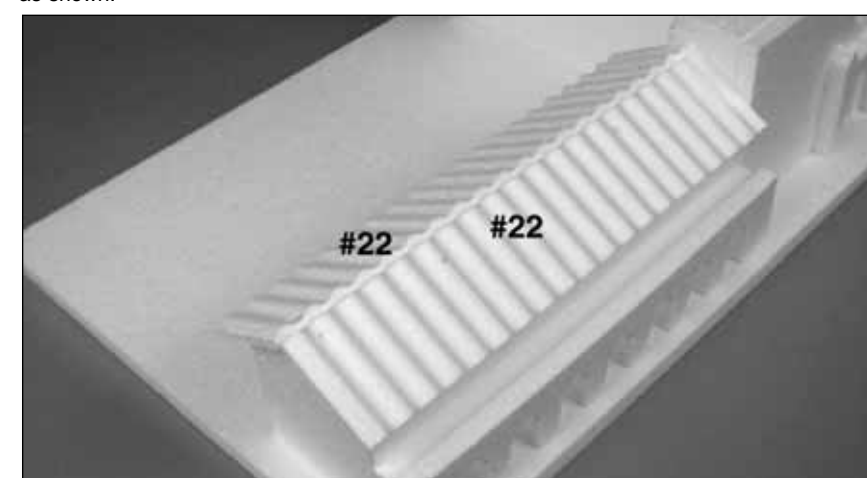
Glue the quarters in place so that the right side is up against the main building and there is 1/2" from the front of the base to the front wall.

- 14. Locate both pieces of #21 Roof material. This is the roof of the main building. You will need to cut (using scissors) each #21 roof piece so that it will fit tightly around each bell tower. Put the right side of the roof in place and mark where the bell tower meets the roof. Using scissors, cut on that mark, 5/8" into the roof (first cut). Then, cut from the end of the roof to the 5/8" cut (second cut). This cut is 1-7/8" long. The roof will now fit "snug" up against the bell tower.

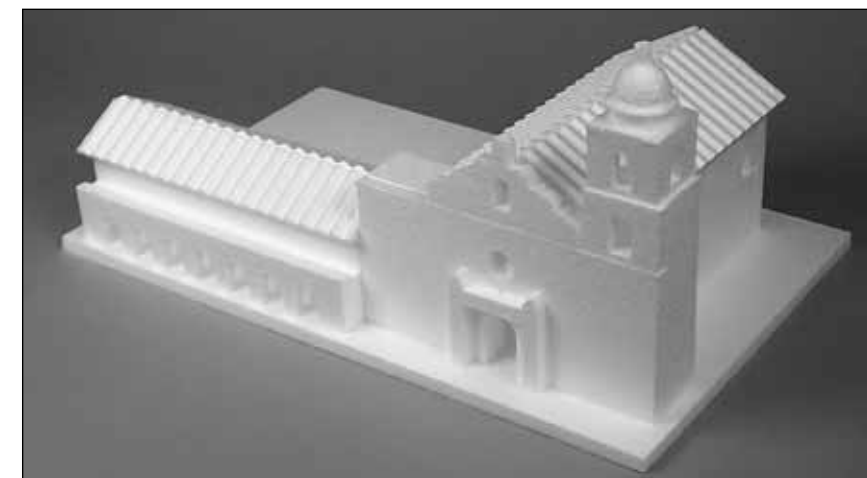
Repeat this step for the left side. Your cut will be 3/8" (first cut) by 1-3/4" (second cut). Apply glue along the top edges of the main building and put the roof pieces in place.



- 15. Apply glue to the roofline edges of the quarters and glue the #22 roof pieces in place as shown.



- 16. Run a bead of glue where the roof pieces meet and allow them to dry.



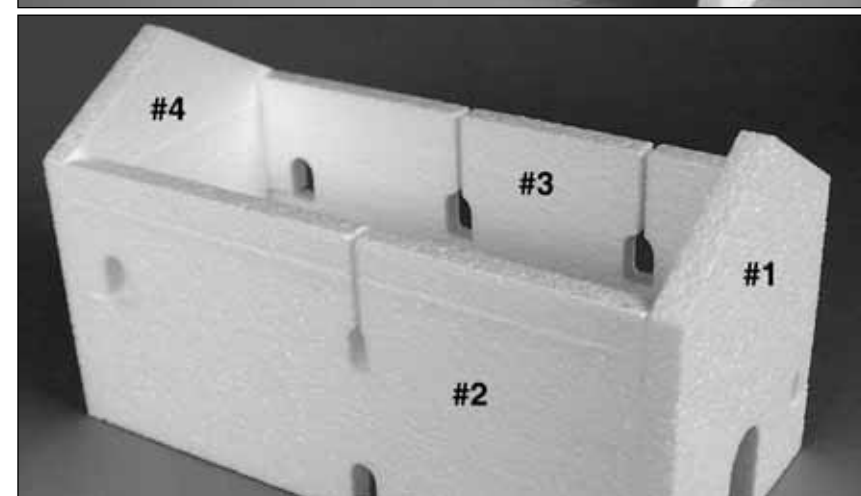
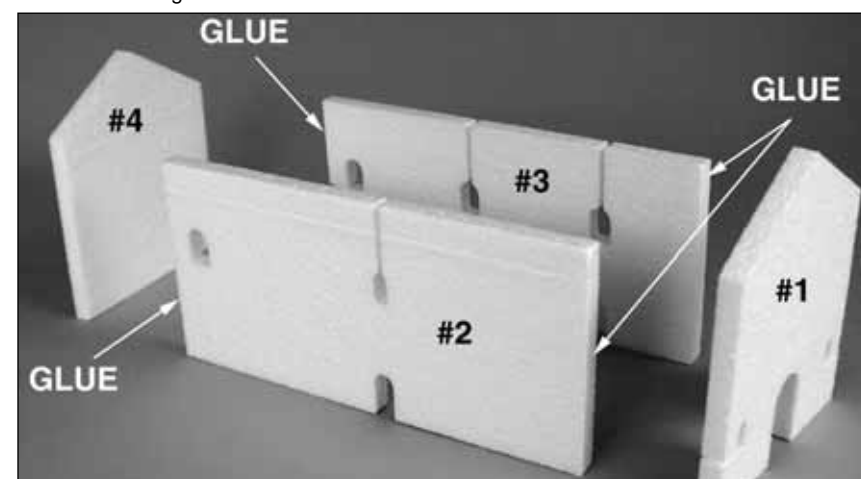
FINISHING

- When you paint your model, use only water-based paints.
- Check with your favorite hobby dealer for accessories such as grass, shrubbery, grave markers, figures...etc. that will add realism to your model.

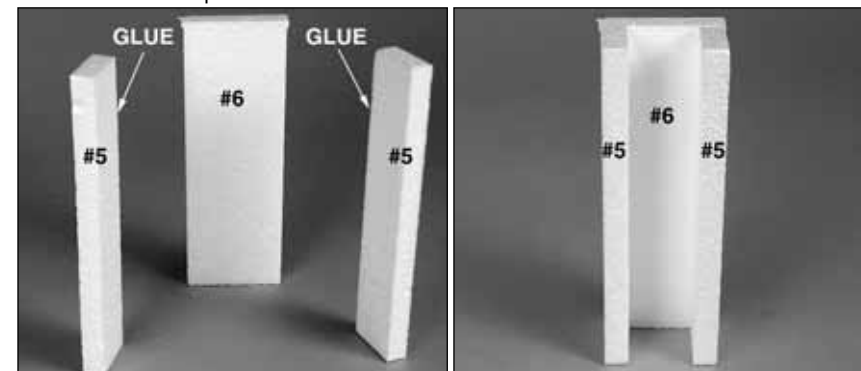
ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Place the 24"x15" base on a clean, flat surface.

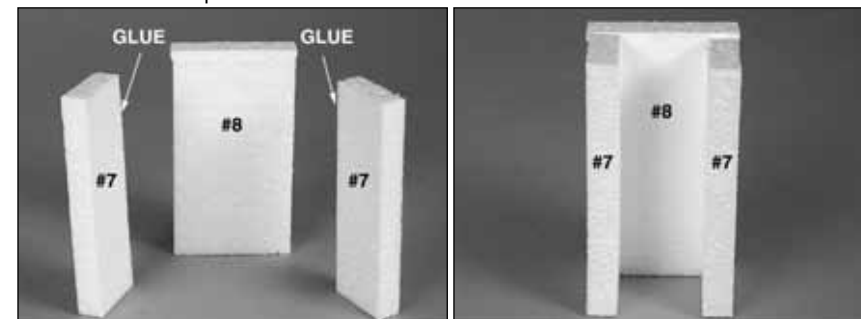
- 2. Apply glue along the front edges of #2, and #3 and place it against #1 as shown. Apply glue on the rear edges of side #2 and side #3 and put #4 in place. This section will be called the "main building".



- 3. Glue both #5 pieces onto #6 as shown.



- 4. Glue both #7 pieces onto #8 as shown.



- 5. Glue the sections from steps 3 and 4 to piece #9 as shown. This section will be called the "bell tower".
