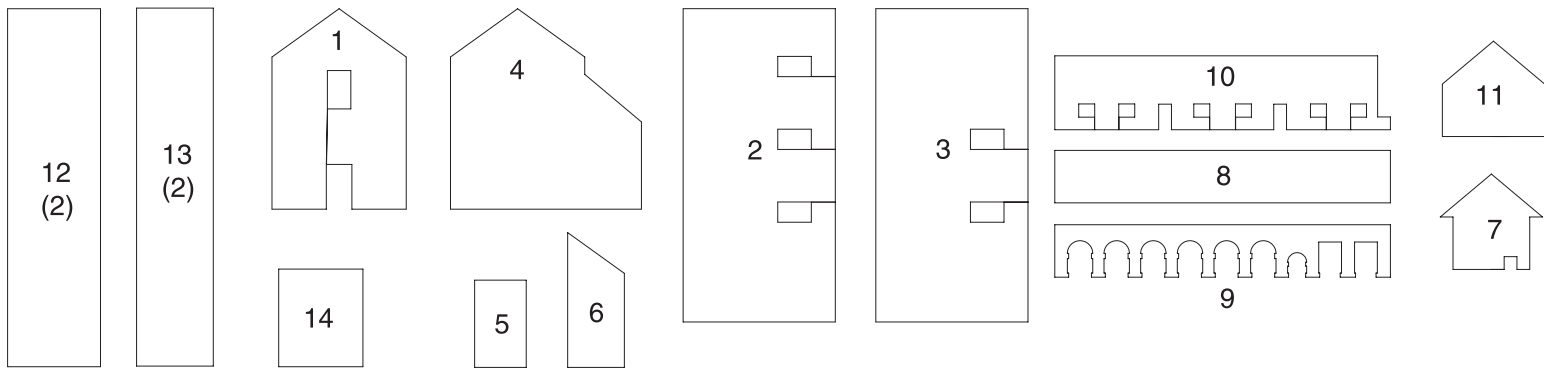


San Miguel Archangel Instructions

Parts Drawing

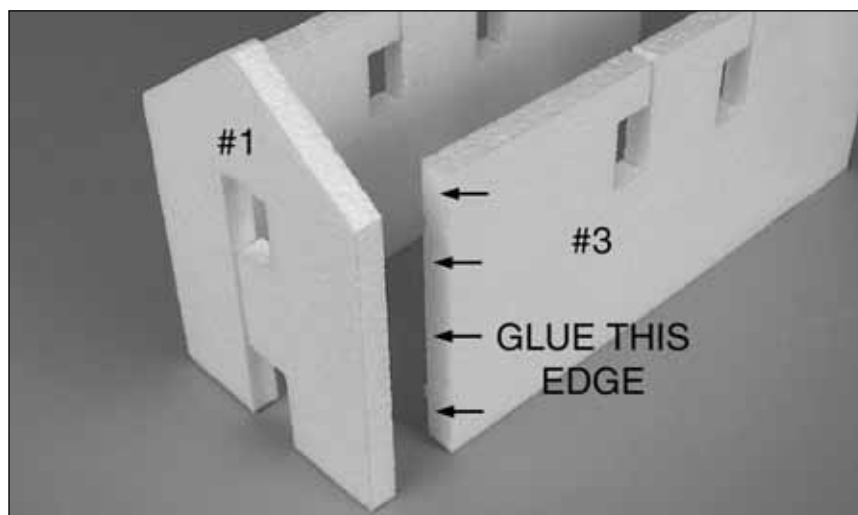
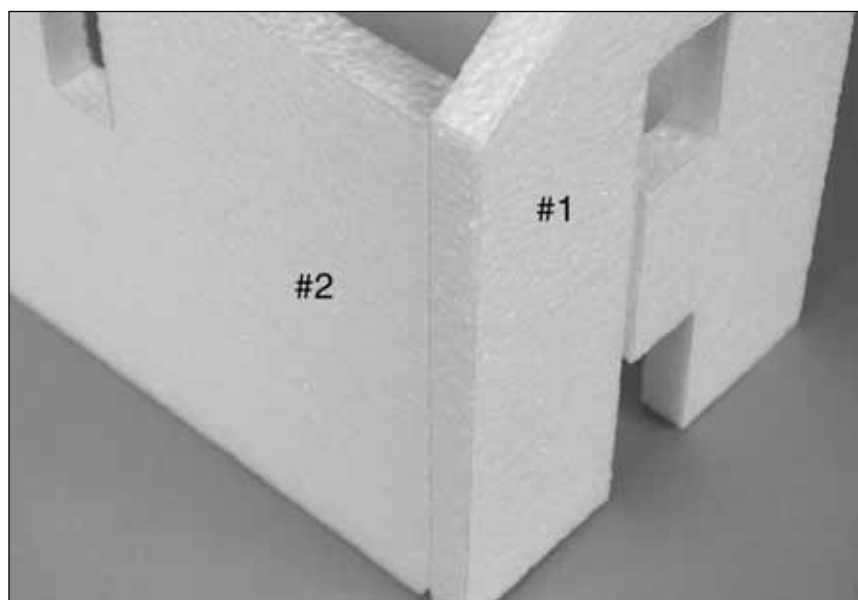
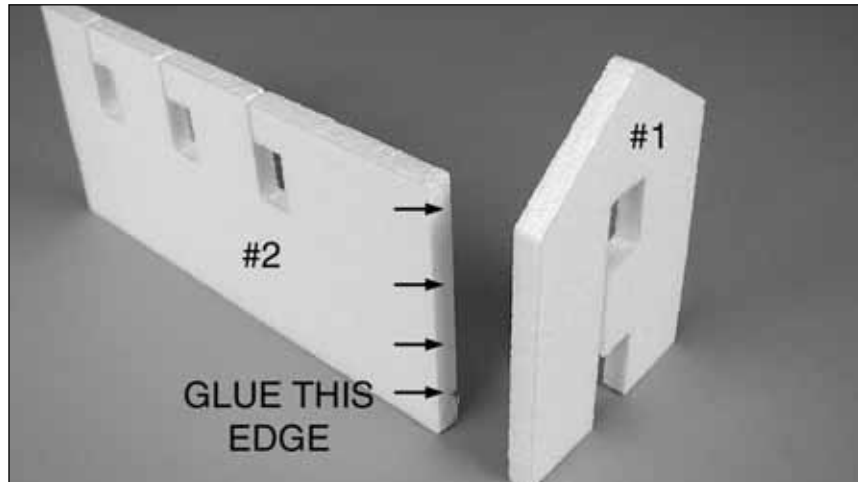


- Before starting assembly, read through each step of the instructions and carefully study each photo. As you put the model together, it is a good idea to "test" fit the pieces together before using any glue.
- Spread out newspaper across the table or desk that you are working on. This will help to protect your work surface.
- Use scissors to trim any pieces where needed. PARENTAL SUPERVISION is recommended.
- Identify each piece of the model by matching it with the parts drawing above.
- Assemble the model with standard white glue. It is a good idea to hold the pieces together with toothpicks until the glue is dry. Once the glue is dry, twist the toothpick and carefully pull it out.
- Use a small brush, flat stick, or your finger to spread glue evenly on the surface.
- Do not glue any of the pieces to the base until after Step 6 is completed.

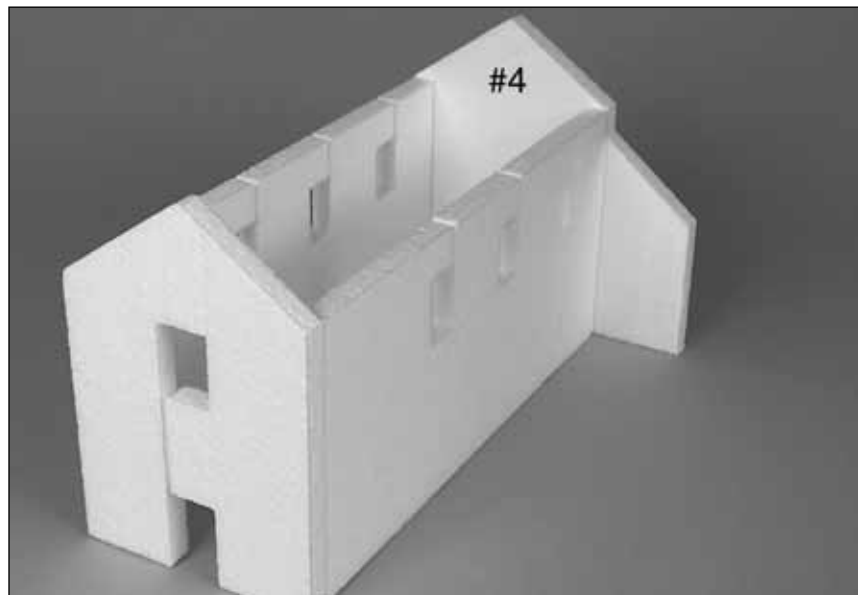
Note: The missions can either be assembled on the cardboard sheet (included) or on a sheet of foam (not included).

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

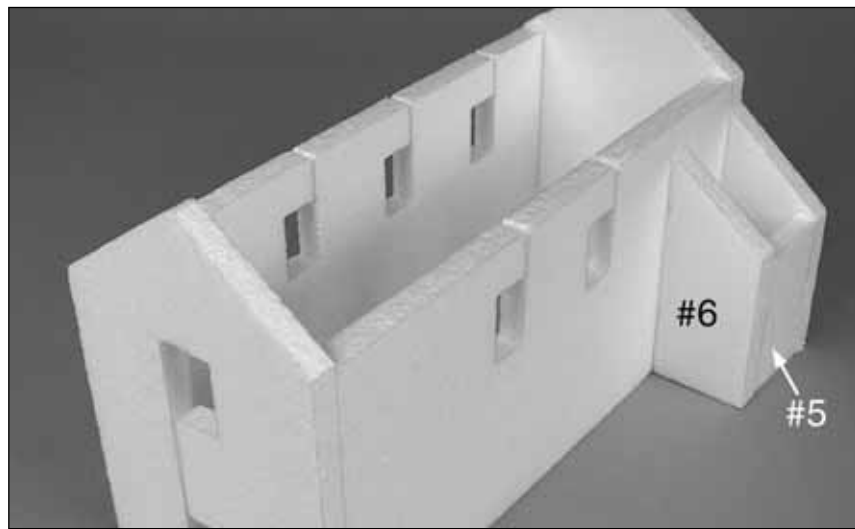
1. Place the 24" x 15" base on a clean, flat surface.
2. Apply glue along the front edge of #2 and #3. Place it against #1 as shown below. Make sure the edges meet evenly.



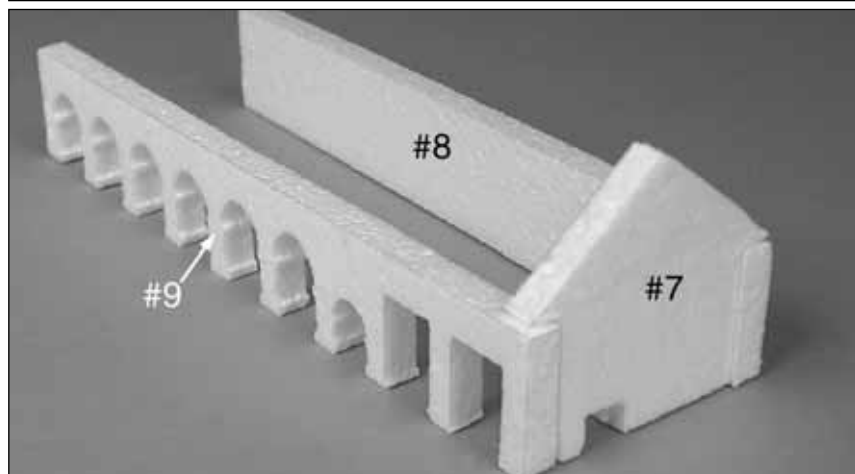
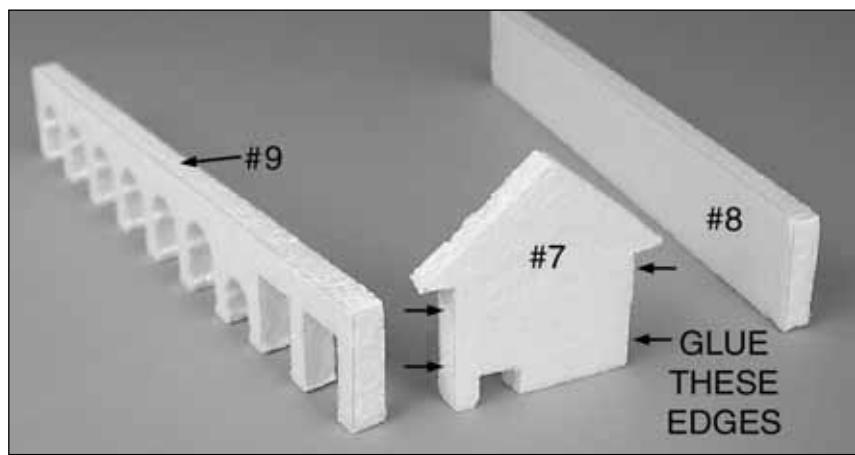
3. Apply glue on the rear edges of #2 and #3. Put #4 in place and line up the edges so they are even. The rear wall of #4 will stick out on the right side.



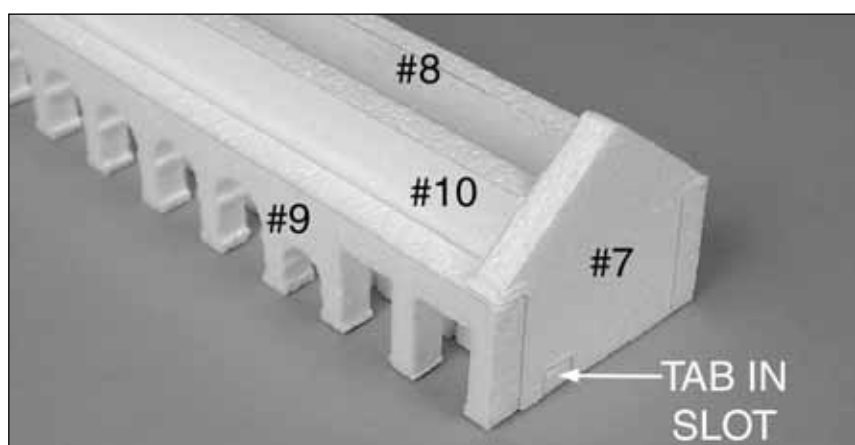
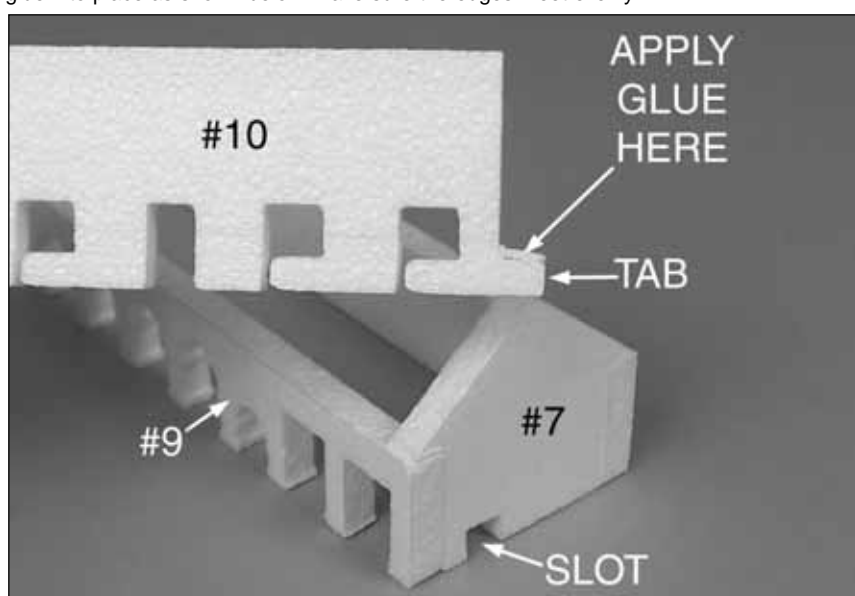
4. Apply glue along the front edge of #5 and place it against #6 as shown in the photos that follow. Make sure the edges meet evenly. Glue #5 and #6 into place as shown in the photos that follow. This is the "main building."



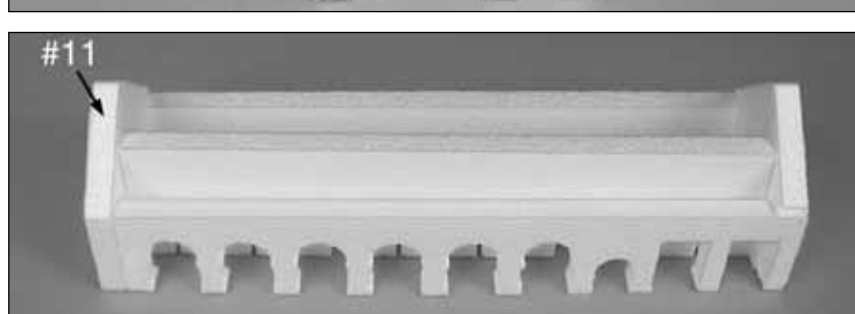
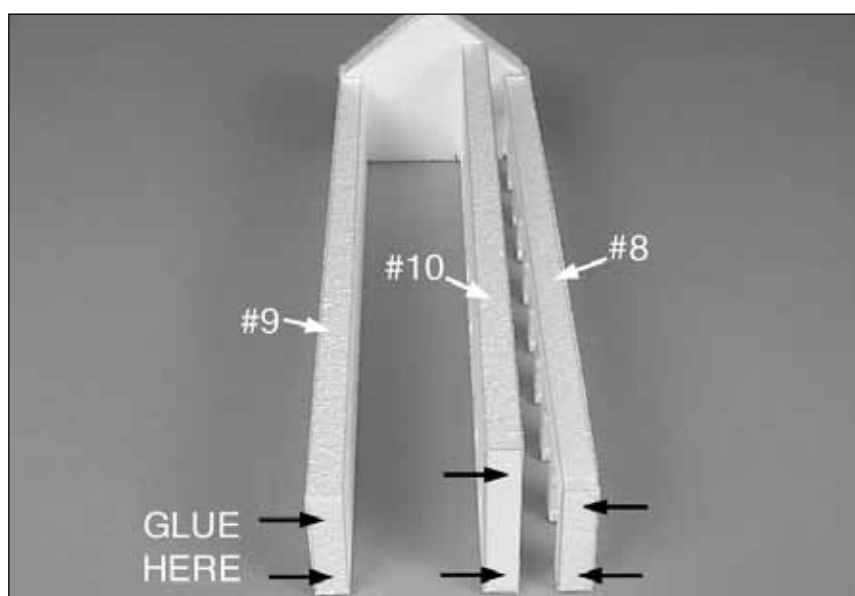
5. Locate #7 and glue pieces #8 and #9 into place as shown below. Make sure all edges meet evenly.



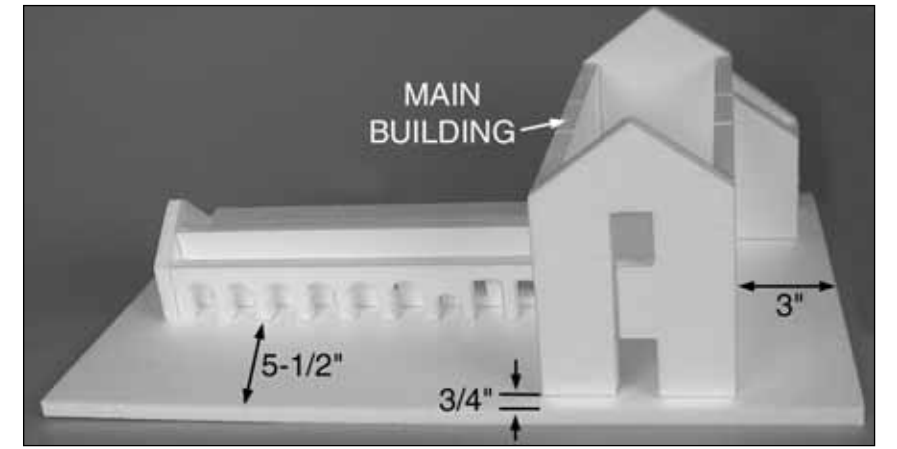
6. Locate the tab on piece #10 and slide it into the small slot at the bottom of side #7 and glue into place as shown below. Make sure the edges meet evenly.



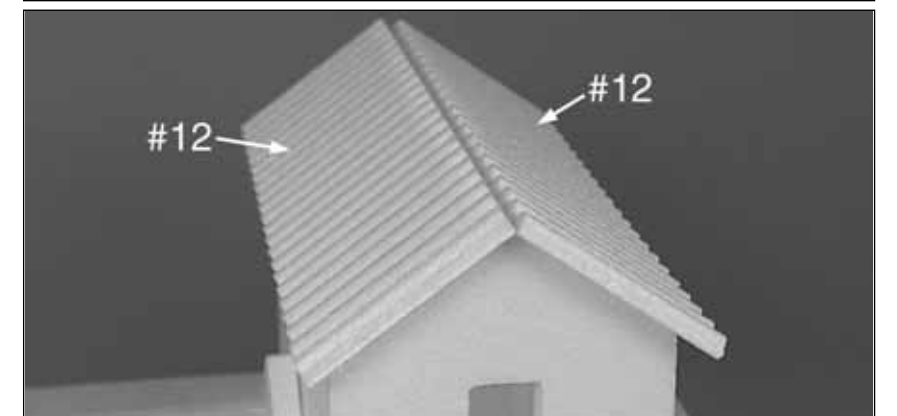
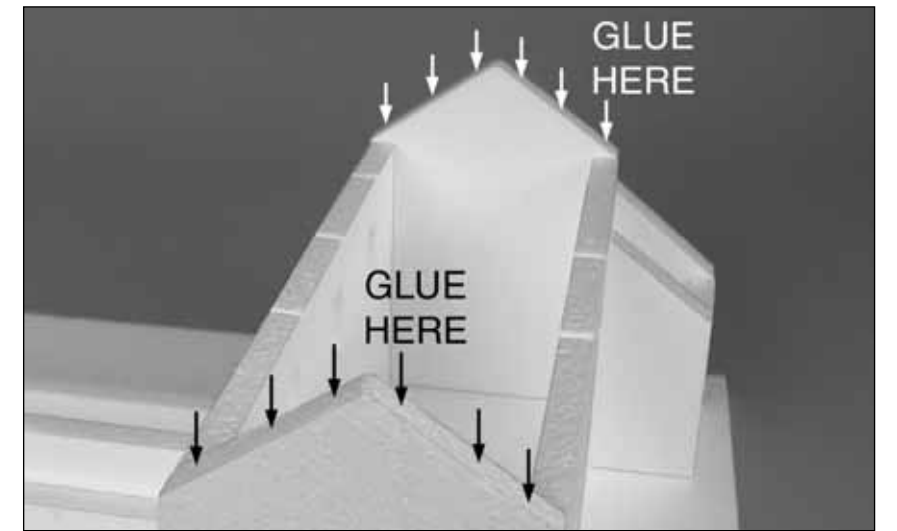
7. Apply glue on the edges of pieces #8, #9, and #10 and place #11 against them as shown below.



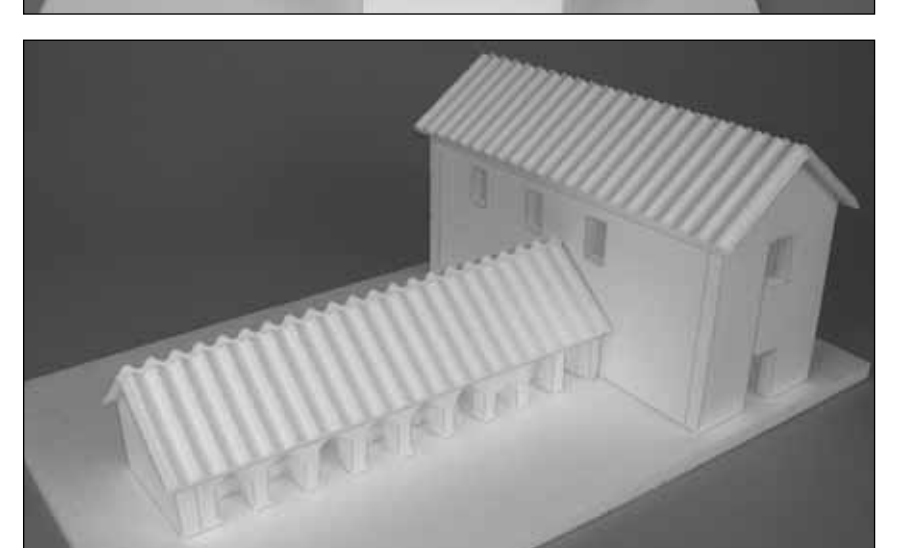
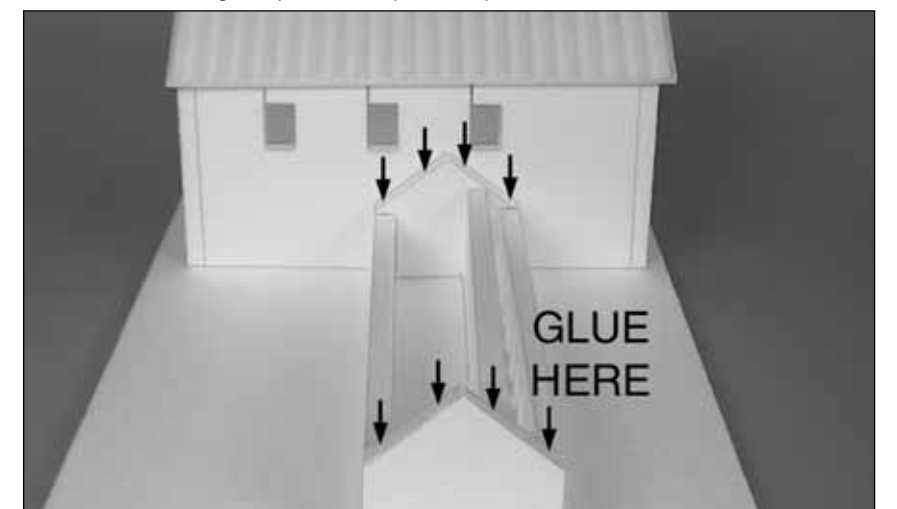
8. Now that the two basic sections of the mission are complete, the mission can be glued to the base. Glue the main building in place on the right hand side of the base so that there is about 3/4" in front and back. The right side of the main building should be about 3" from the edge of the base. Glue the second building in place so that the right wall fits up against the main building and the front wall is about 5-1/2" from the front edge of the base. This will leave you room to create scenery for your model.



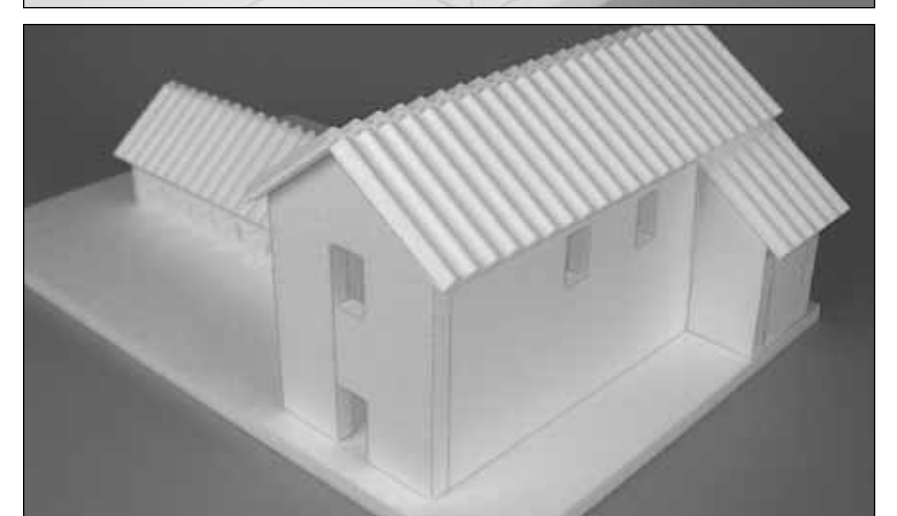
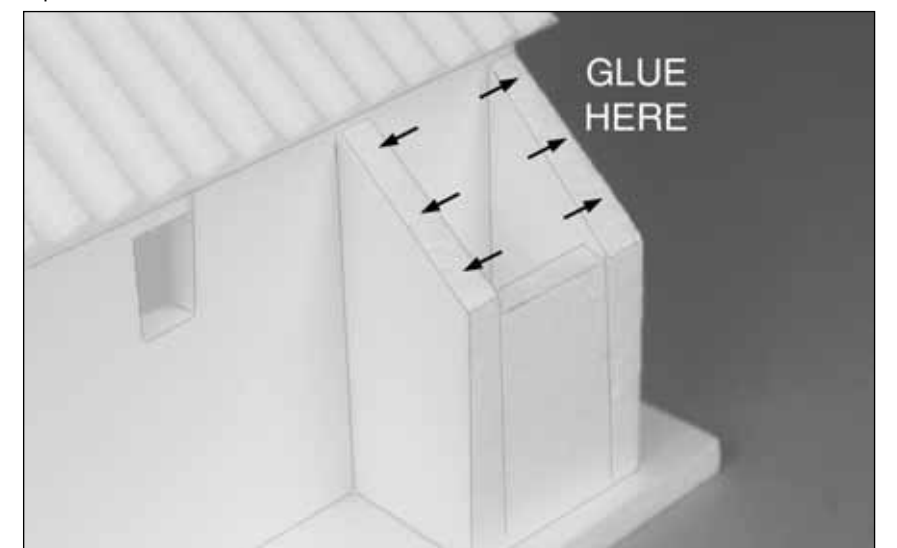
9. Locate the (2) pieces of #12. Apply glue along the roofline on the front and back of the church and put the roof pieces in place.



10. Locate the (2) pieces of #13. Apply glue along the roofline on the right and left walls of the second building and put the roof pieces in place.



11. Locate #14. Apply glue along the roofline of the room and put the roof piece in place.



FINISHING

- When you paint your model, use only water-based paints.
- Check with your favorite hobby dealer for accessories such as grass, shrubbery, grave markers, action figures...etc. that will add realism to your model.
