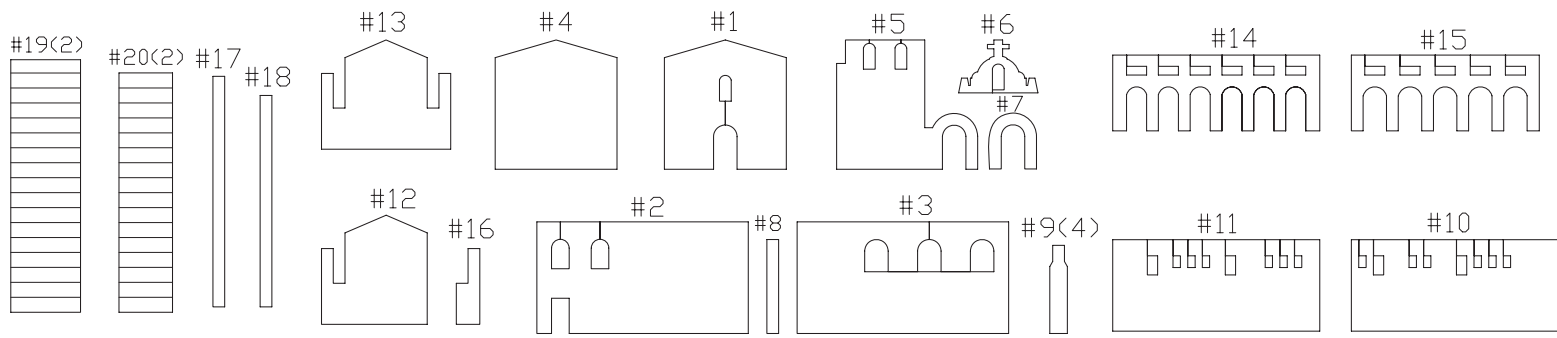


Santa Ines Instructions

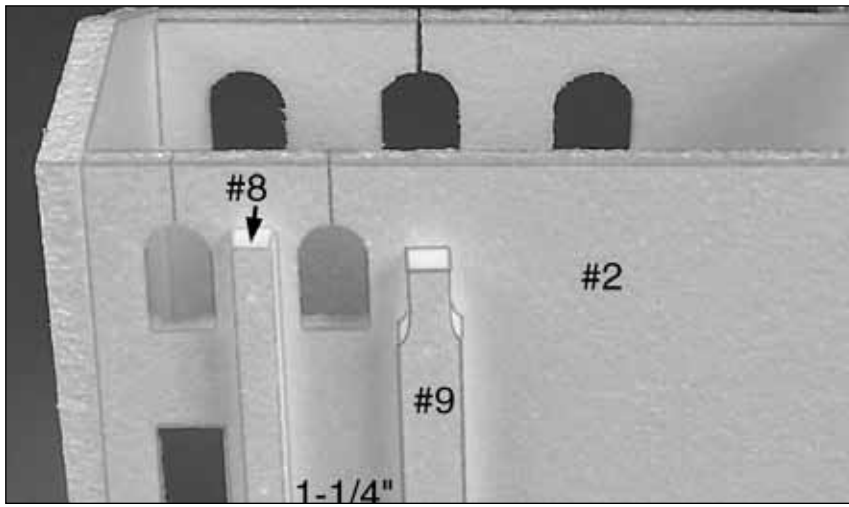
Parts Drawing



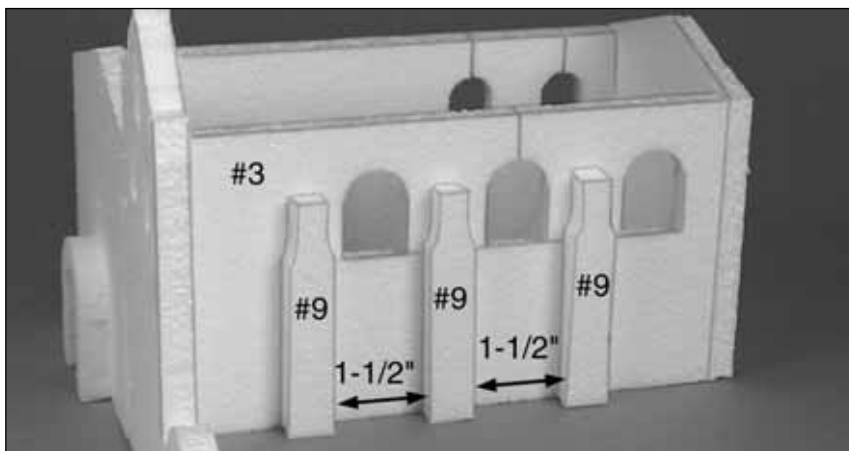
- Before starting assembly, read through each step of the instructions and carefully study each photo. As you put the model together, it is a good idea to "test" fit the pieces together before using any glue.
- Spread out newspaper across the table or desk that you are working on. This will help to protect your work surface.
- Use scissors to trim any pieces where needed. PARENTAL SUPERVISION is recommended.
- Identify each piece of the model by matching it with the parts drawing above.
- Assemble the model with standard white glue. It is a good idea to hold the pieces together with toothpicks until the glue is dry. Once the glue is dry, twist the toothpick and carefully pull it out.
- Use a small brush, flat stick, or your finger to spread glue evenly on the surface.
- Do not glue any of the pieces to the base until after Step 10.

Note: The missions can either be assembled on the cardboard sheet (included) or on a sheet of foam (not included).

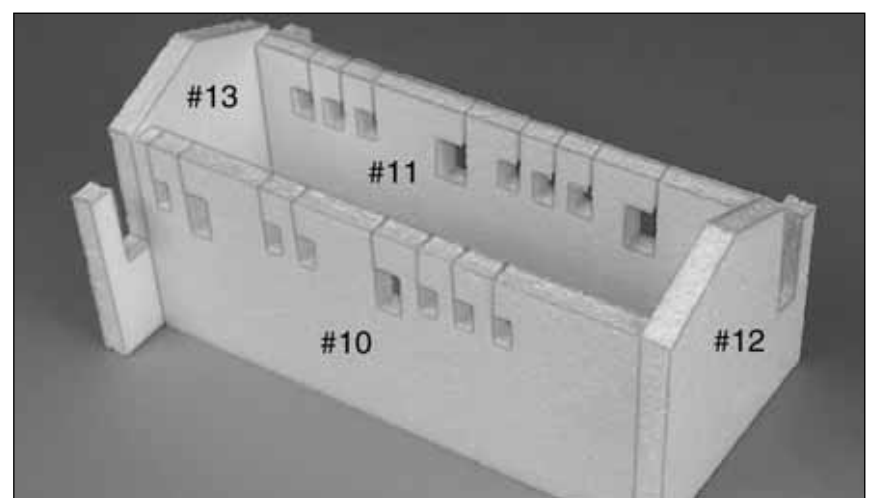
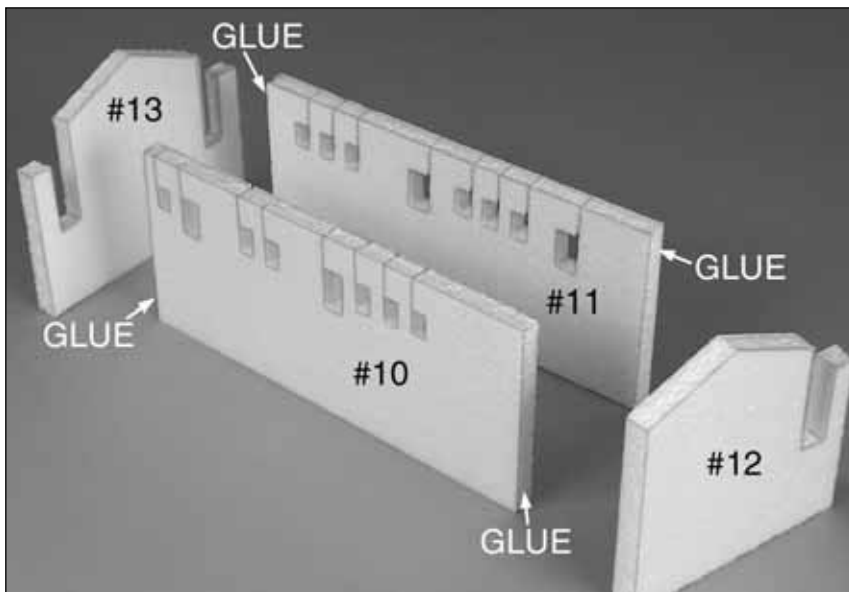
- 5. Apply glue to one of the sides of piece #8. Place it directly between the two windows of side #2 of the main building as shown below. Glue one of the #9 pieces in place 1-1/4" forward of #8.



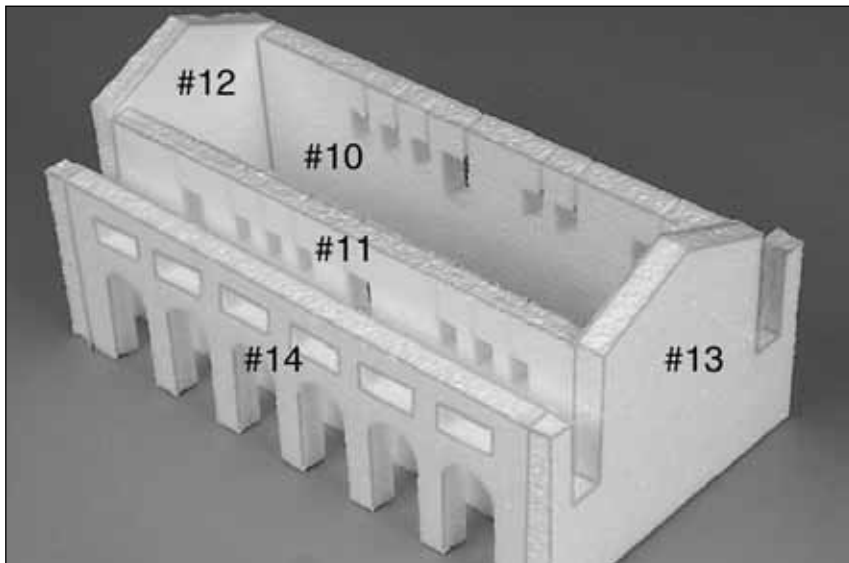
- 6. Glue the three remaining #9 pieces in place on side #3 of the main building as shown below. There should be 1-1/2" between each pillar.



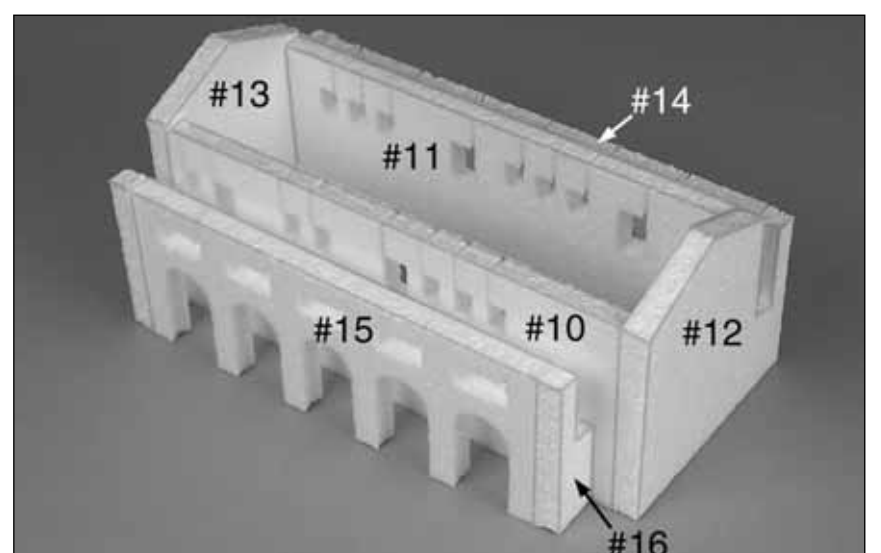
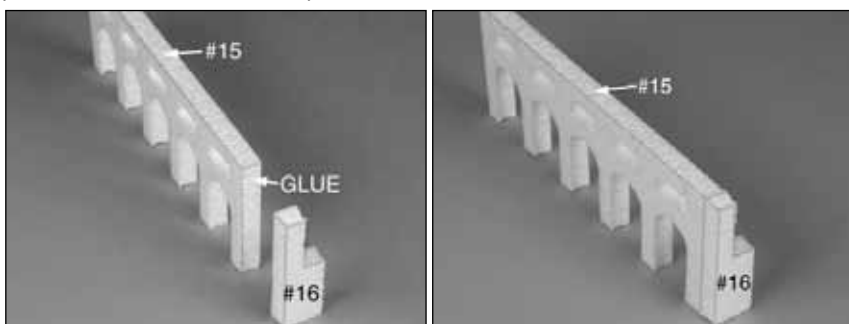
- 7. Apply glue to both ends of #10 and #11. Put pieces #12 and #13 in place as shown below. Note the direction of all pieces. This section will be called the "quarters."



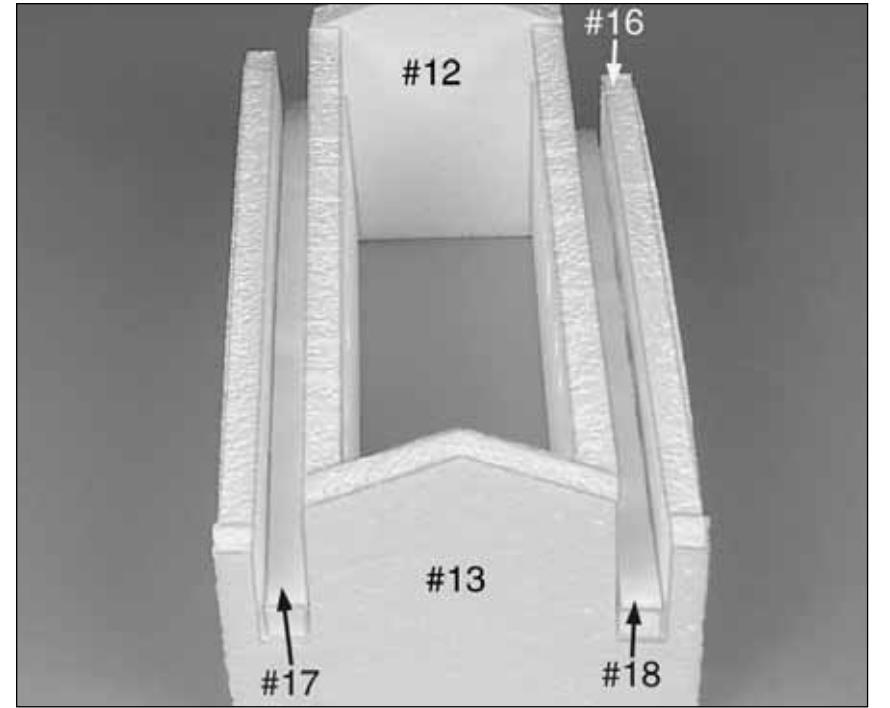
- 8. Apply glue to both edges of #14. Put it in place between #12 and #13 as shown below.



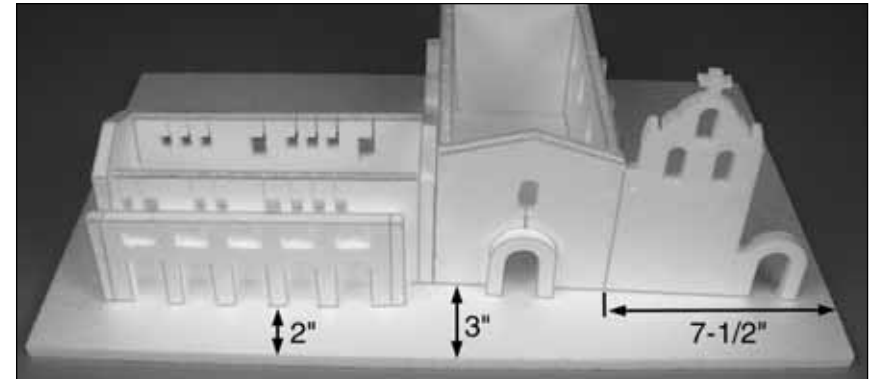
- 9. Glue pieces #15 and #16 together as shown below. This section can then be glued into place onto the front side of the quarters.



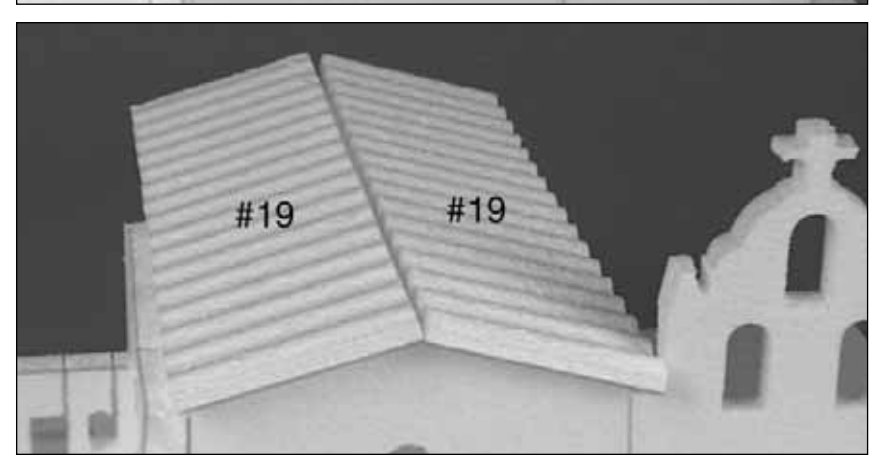
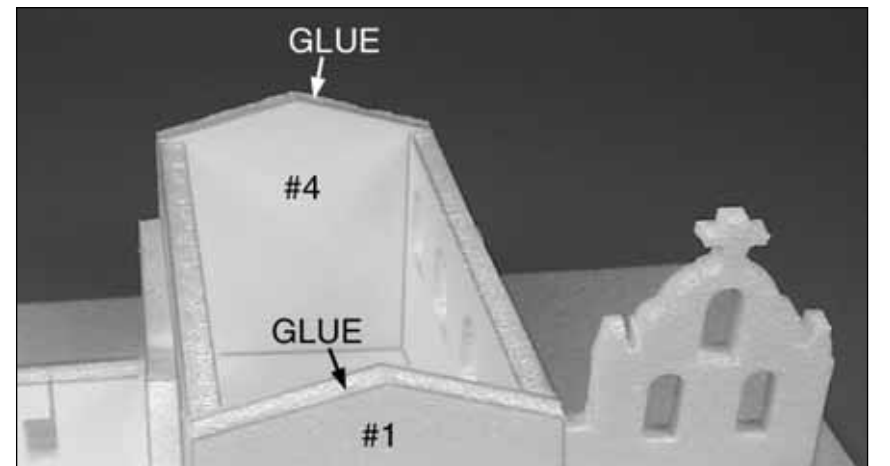
- 10. Glue #17 into place between #12 and #13 at the rear of the quarters and #18 into place between #12 and #16 on the front of the quarters as shown below.



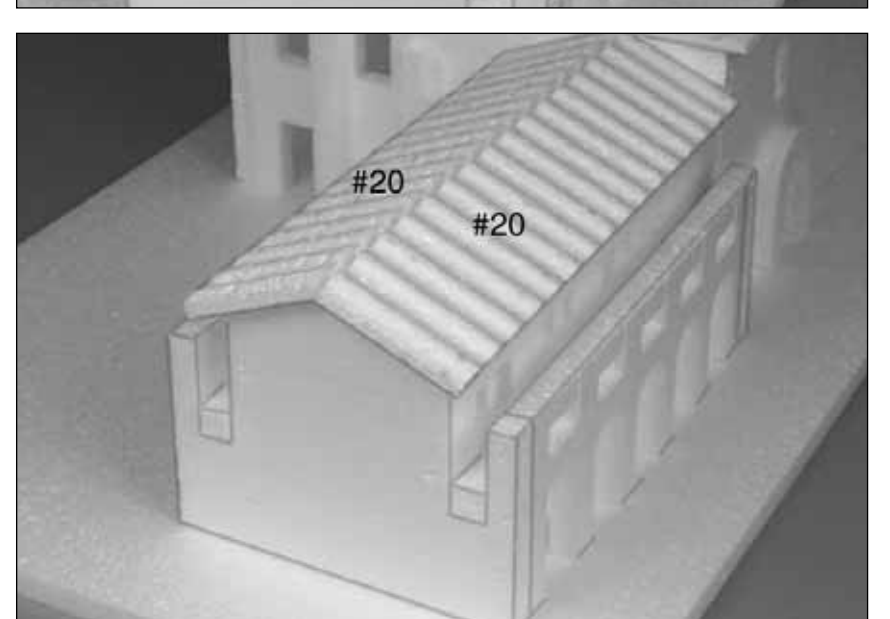
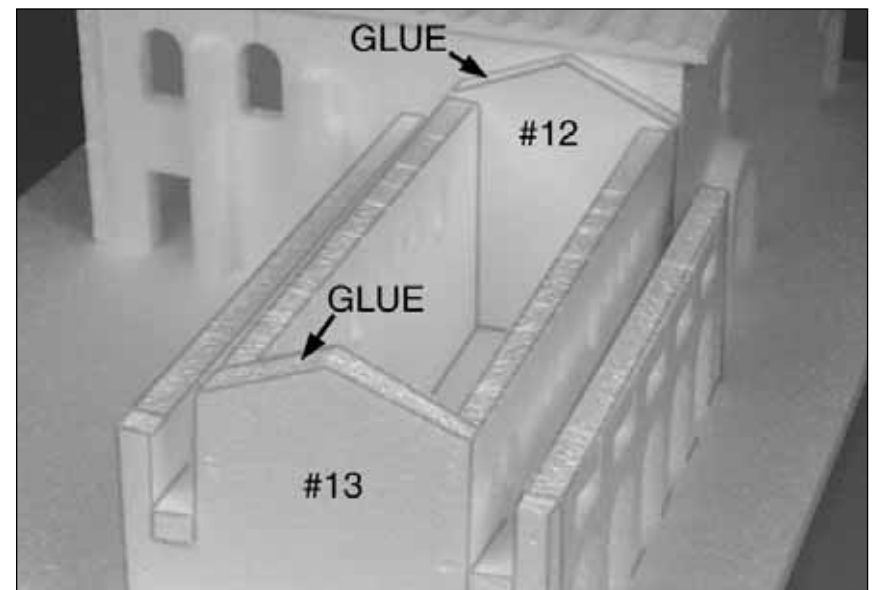
- 11. Now the sections can be glued to the base. Glue the main building in place so that the front wall is 3" from the front of the base and the right side of the main building (not including the bell tower) is 7-1/2" from the edge of the base as shown. Glue the quarters in place so that the right side is up against the main building and there is 2" from the front wall to the front edge of the base. This will leave you enough room to create scenery for your model.



- 12. Locate both #19 pieces. This is the roof of the main building. Apply glue to the roofing edges of #1 and #4 and put the roof pieces in place as shown below.



- 13. Locate both #20 pieces. This is the roof of the quarters. Apply glue to the roofing edges of #12 and #13 and put the roof pieces in place as shown below.



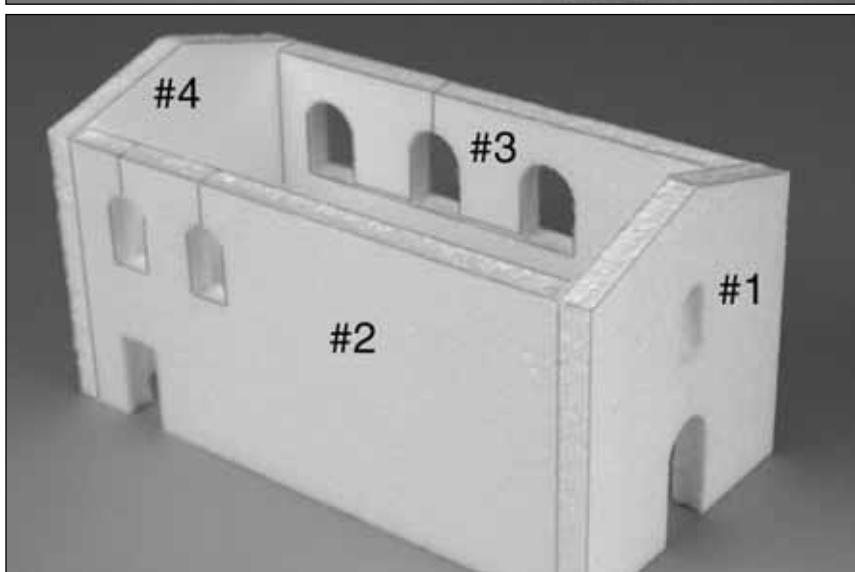
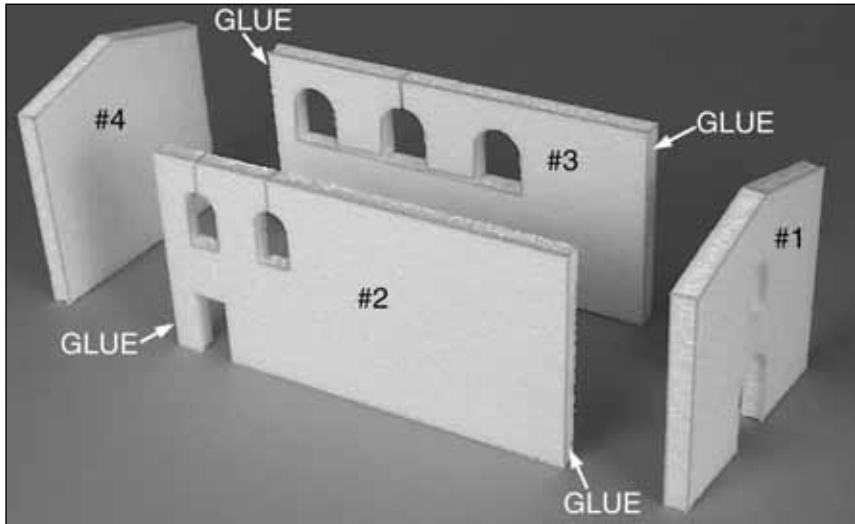
FINISHING

- When you paint your model, use only water-based paints.
- Check with your favorite hobby dealer for accessories such as grass, shrubbery, grave markers, action figures...etc. that will add realism to your model.

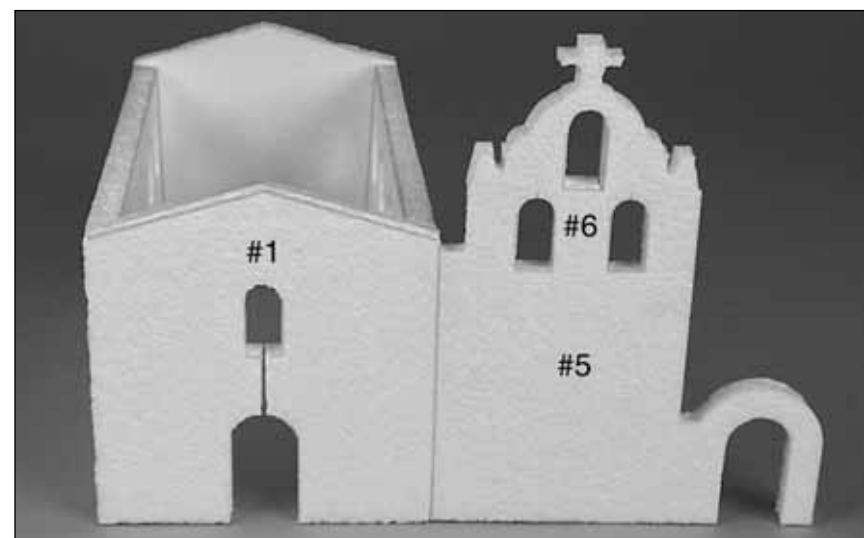
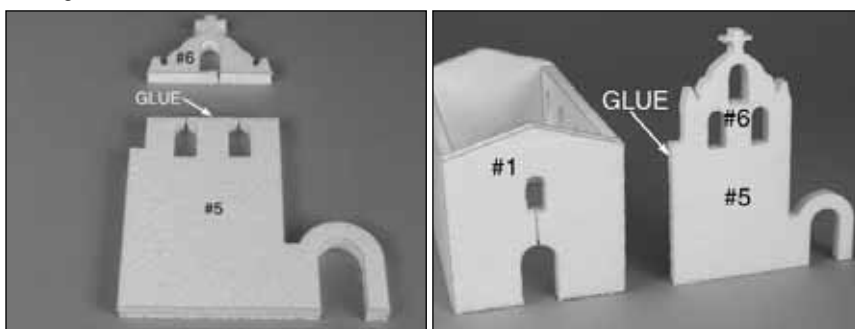
ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Place the 24" x 15" base on a clean, flat surface.

- 2. Apply glue along the front edges of #2 and #3 and place them against #1 as shown below. Apply glue on the rear edges of both #2 and #3 and put #4 in place. Make sure all edges are even. This section will be called the "main building."



- 3. Apply glue to the top edge of #5 and glue #6 into place as shown below. This section will be called the "bell tower." Glue the bell tower to the main building as shown. Make sure the edges are even.



- 4. Glue piece #7 over the front doorway of the main building as shown below.
